

Basingstoke Health and care

The health and care sector in Basingstoke is the largest employer within the borough, accounting for almost 11,000 people.

Latest figures reveal that the industry generated a total GVA figure of £454million in 2022, working out as six percent of the total Basingstoke economy. While the sector is currently functioning at the national average rate with a location quotient of 1.02, job growth of 2.8% from 2020 to 2021 demonstrates an encouraging sign for the sector. While the impacts of the pandemic will have had a role in this increase, it demonstrates the value of health and care on an economic basis.

The sector is widely driven by Basingstoke and North Hampshire Hospital which is part of Hampshire Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust (HHFT) and serves approximately 600,000 people across the whole of Hampshire and into West Berkshire. The trust employs 8,600 staff members and operates three hospitals in the Hampshire region seeing 639,508 outpatients and 137,052 emergency attendances*. Basingstoke and North Hampshire Hospital has led in special areas of medical care as well as technological advancement. The hospital boasts a purpose-built Diagnosis and Treatment Centre while also becoming the first European hospital to perform surgery using voice operated equipment in 1999.


