

# Basingstoke Construction

The construction sector in Basingstoke is one that has experienced continual growth.

With an industry GVA that made up 9% of the borough's total GVA in 2022, the construction industry is of significant importance to the Basingstoke and Deane economy. Although it is not considered a priority sector, the industry has had a significant role in helping to deliver new homes in the borough as part of the Local Plan and supporting redevelopment in the borough through several projects.

The construction sector employs around 5,000 people in the borough, ranking as the joint 5th sector (Nomis). This is a clear indicator that the construction industry has strong roots in Basingstoke and Deane and is a significant employer for the residents of the borough. GVA for the construction industry increased by £190million from 2021 to 2022.

The town enjoys a great network of likeminded businesses ensuring cross collaboration, support and increased market opportunities.



#### Manydown

As joint owner of the long lease of 2,000 acres of land at Manydown, to the west of Basingstoke, the borough is set to benefit sustainable new communities of connected neighbourhoods, combining the best features from Hampshire villages and towns with a contemporary sustainable design.

The first development at Manydown North will see the creation of a new community of up to 3,520 homes including 1,400 affordable homes, a 250-acre countryside park, schools and other mixed uses. Further work is under way to explore how land at South Manydown that could be brought forward over the next 30 years.


