

Moods Photography Guidelines

As a general rule, cameras are not permitted at Moods. Anyone wishing to take photographs with a larger camera must obtain accreditation in advance. Otherwise, the camera may be confiscated or entry may be refused altogether. When submitting your request, please also let us know where the photos will be published. You can send your accreditation request to info@moods.ch.

The following guidelines apply to photographers accredited by Moods:

- Photography is permitted during the first three songs (maximum 15 minutes), unless otherwise agreed with the Moods team.
- Always behave as discreetly as possible and be considerate of the audience.
- No use of flash.
- No use of continuous lighting.
- No use of AF assist light (autofocus assist light).
- Use silent shutter or digital shutter.
- No audio/video recording.
- No video recording/photography on stage.
- No video recording/photography in the backstage area.
- The material should be shared with Moods if possible.

All Moods employees and artist managers are authorized to give instructions.
