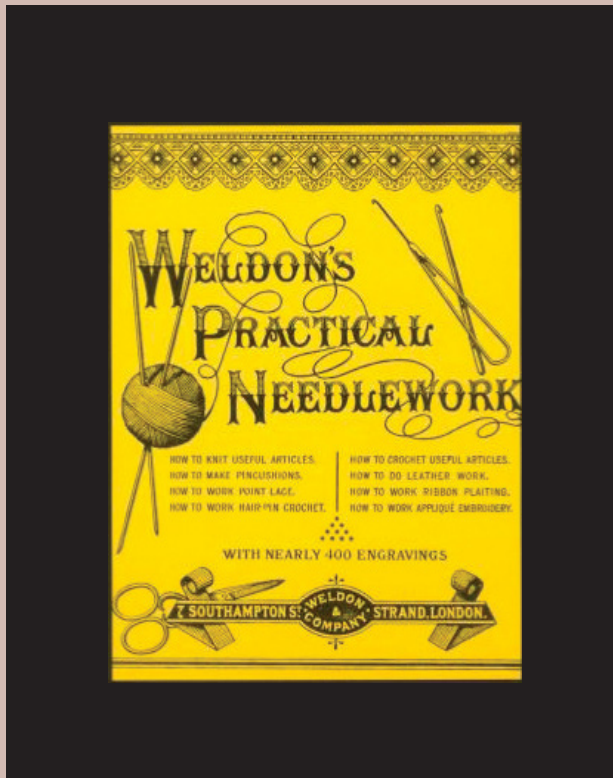

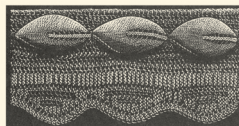
This electronic pattern book opens a window on another time and another place. The time is the turn of the twentieth century and the place is London, England. Needleworkers of that era would be amazed to see their favorite knitting patterns in a virtual format of which they could never have dreamed.

In an effort to bring needlework to the emerging middle class, Weldon's, a paper pattern company of the Victorian era, began to publish monthly newsletters devoted to various crafts (beading, knitting, crochet, patchwork, and the like). These newsletters were typically 14 pages and cost 2 pence. Later, they were collected into book form, titled Weldon's Practical Needlework. This series was included in Volume 10.

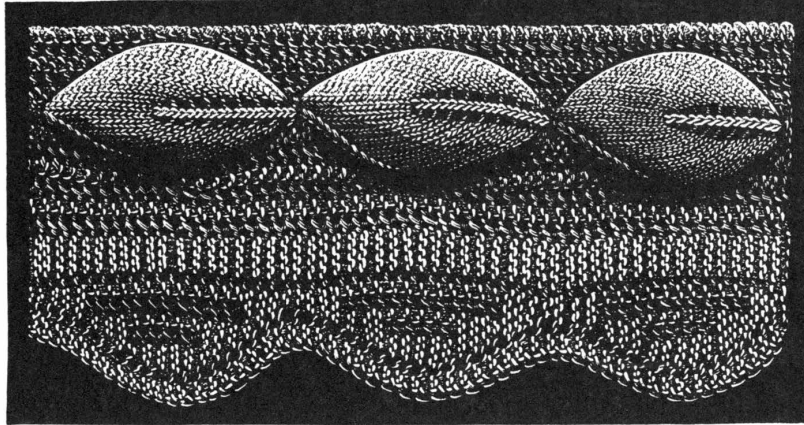
We have reproduced for you here the knitting material from the Twenty-Seventh Series. The 27 designs range from practical to ornate and include instructions for a lovely tassel, stunning Greek pattern lace, delicate Sybil lace, and the Dorinda edging, particularly suited to edge a pincushion.

Instructions might perplex a contemporary knitter accustomed to detailed charts and succinct directions, but the patterns are often ingenious, and many of the objects transcend the century-plus span of years since they were devised.

This electronic book serves as a curiosity, an inspiration, a resource, and a link to a time beyond our memories. In using and enjoying it, you keep the craft alive.

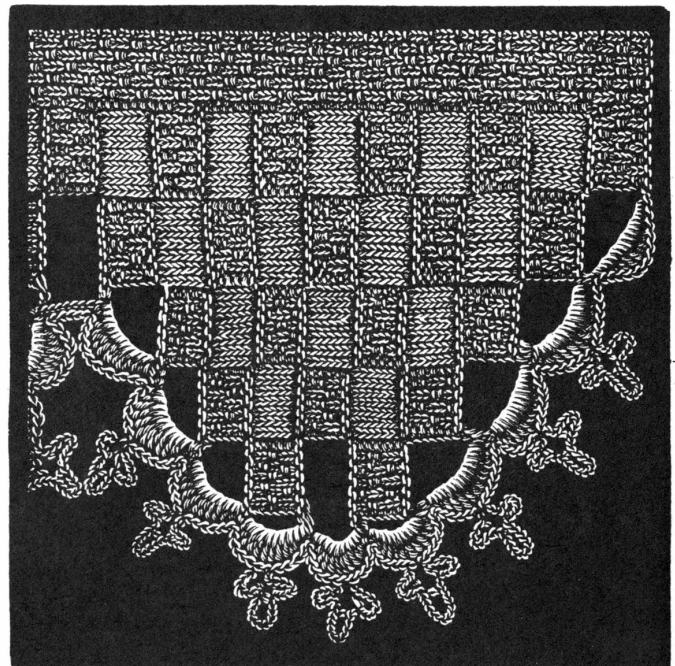

GREEK PATTERN LACE.

A DEEP and handsome lace suited for edging counterpanes and such articles. The crochet which is carried all round the edge adds considerably to its effect. Worked with Struts' knitting cotton No. 8 and steel pins No. 16, the greatest depth is about 5½ inches. Cast on 14 stitches. **1st row**—Knit 2, * purl 1, knit 1, repeat from * five times. **2nd row**—* Purl 1, knit 1, repeat from * five times, purl 2. **3rd row**—* Knit 1, purl 1, repeat from * five times, knit 2. **4th row**—Purl 2, * knit 1, purl 1, repeat from * five times. **5th row**—Like first row. **6th row**—Like second row. **7th row**—Cast on 7, purl the 7 cast on, knit 7, purl 1, knit 1, purl 1, knit 1, purl 1, knit 2. **8th row**—Purl 2, knit 1, purl 1, knit 1, purl 2, knit 7, purl 2, knit 1, purl 1, knit 1, purl 2. **9th row**—* Knit 1, purl 1, repeat from * twice, knit 1, purl 7, * knit 1, purl 1, repeat from * twice, knit 1. **10th row**—* Purl 1, knit 1, repeat from * twice, purl 1, knit 7, * purl 1, knit 1, repeat from * twice, purl 1. **11th row**—Knit 2, purl 1, knit 1, purl 1, knit 2, purl 7, knit 2, purl 1, knit 1, purl 1, knit 2. **12th row**—Like 8th row. **13th row**—Cast on 7, purl the 7 cast on, knit 7, purl 7, * knit 1, purl 1, repeat from * twice, knit 1. **14th row**—* Purl 1, knit 1, repeat from * twice, purl 8, knit 7, * purl 1, knit 1, repeat from * twice, purl 1. **15th row**—* Knit 1, purl 1, repeat from * twice, knit 1, purl 7, * knit 1, purl 1, repeat from * five times, knit 2. **16th row**—Purl 2, * knit 1, purl 1, repeat from * five times, knit 7, purl 2, knit 1, purl 1, purl 2. **17th row**—Knit 2, purl 1, knit 1, purl 1, knit 2, purl 7, knit 2, * purl 1, knit 1, repeat from * five times. **18th row**—* Purl 1, knit 1, repeat from * five times, purl 2, knit 7, * purl 1, knit 1, repeat from * twice, purl 1. **19th row**—Cast on 7, purl the 7 cast on, knit 7, purl 7, knit 7, purl 1, knit 1, purl 1, knit 1, purl 1, knit 2. **20th row**—Purl 2, knit 1, purl 1, knit 1, purl 2, knit 7, purl 7, knit 7, purl 2, knit 1, purl 1, knit 1, purl 2. **21st row**—* Knit 1, purl 1, repeat from * twice, knit 1, purl 7, repeat from the first * once, then * knit 1, purl 1, repeat from the last * twice, knit 1. **22nd row**—* Purl 1, knit 1, repeat from * twice, purl 1, knit 7, † purl 1, knit 1, repeat from † twice, purl 1, knit 7, * purl 1, knit 1, repeat from * twice, purl 1. **23rd row**—* Knit 2, purl 1, knit 1, purl 1, knit 2, purl 7, repeat from * once, knit 2, purl 1, knit 1, purl 1, knit 2. **24th row**—* Purl 2, knit 1, purl 1, knit 1, purl 2, knit 7, repeat from * once, purl 2, knit 1, purl 1, knit 1, purl 2. **25th row**—Cast on 7, purl the 7 cast on, knit 7, purl 7, knit 7, purl 7, * knit 1, purl 1, repeat from * twice, knit 1. **26th row**—* Purl 1, knit 1, repeat from

* twice, purl 8, knit 7, purl 7, knit 7, * purl 1, knit 1, repeat from * twice, purl 1. **27th row**—* Knit 1, purl 1, repeat from * twice, knit 1, purl 7, repeat from the beginning of the row once, * knit 1, purl 1, repeat from the last * five times, knit 2. **28th row**—Purl 2, * knit 1, purl 1, repeat from * five times, knit 7, purl 2, knit 1, purl 1, knit 1, purl 2, knit 7, purl 2, knit 1, purl 1, knit 1, purl 2. **29th row**—Knit 2, purl 1, knit 1, purl 1, knit 2, purl 7, repeat from the beginning of the row once, knit 2, * purl 1, knit 1, repeat from * five times. **30th row**—* Purl 1, knit 1, repeat from * five times, purl 2, knit 7, purl 1, knit 1, purl 1, knit 1, purl 1, knit 1, purl 1, knit 7, purl 1, knit 1, purl 1, knit 1, purl 1, knit 1, purl 1. **31st row**—Cast off 7, purl 6, knit 7, purl 7, knit 9, purl 1, knit 1, purl 1, knit 2. **32nd row**—Purl 2, knit 1, purl 1, knit 1, purl 2, knit 7, purl 7, knit 7, purl 7. Now work again from the beginning of the twenty-first to the end of the thirty-second row. **45th row**—Like twenty-first row. **46th row**—Like twenty-second row. **47th row**—Like twenty-third row. **48th row**—Like twenty-fourth row. **49th row**—Cast off 7, purl 6, knit 7, purl 7, * knit 1, purl 1, repeat from * twice, knit 1. **50th row**—* Purl 1, knit 1, repeat from * twice, purl 8, knit 7, purl 7. **51st row**—Like fifteenth row. **52nd row**—Like sixteenth row. **53rd row**—Like seventeenth row. **54th row**—Like eighteenth row. **55th row**—Cast off 7, purl 6, knit 9, purl 1, knit 1, purl 1, knit 2. **56th row**—Purl 2, knit 1, purl 1, knit 1, purl 2, knit 7, purl 7. **57th row**—Like ninth row. **58th row**—Like tenth row. **59th row**—Like eleventh row. **60th row**—Like eighth row. **61st row**—Cast off 7, purl 6, * knit 1, purl 1, repeat from * twice, knit 1. **62nd row**—* Purl 1, knit 1, repeat from * twice, purl 8. Repeat from the third row. Finish this lace with a bordering of crochet worked in the same texture of cotton and with a coarse steel hook in the following manner—**1st row**—1 double crochet into the tip of the first of the battlements, * 6 chain, 1 double crochet into the tip of the next battlement, repeat from * twice, this brings the worker to the first corner of one of the bottom battlements; 6 chain, 1 double crochet into the opposite corner of the same battlement, 6 chain, 1 double crochet into the first corner of the next battlement, 6 chain, 1 double crochet into the next corner of the same battlement, † 6 chain, 1 double crochet into the next battlement, repeat from † twice, 6 chain, 1 double crochet into the first battlement of the next section, repeat from the first *. **2nd row**—1 double crochet, 7 treble, 1 double crochet into the first loop of 6 chain, * 1 double crochet, 5 treble, 1 triple picot made thus: 5 chain, 1 double crochet in the first of these chain, 7 chain, 1 double crochet in the first of these chain, 5 chain, 1 double crochet into the first, then 1 single into the top of the treble that was worked before beginning the picot—5 treble, 1 double crochet into the same loop of chain, repeat 6 times from *

then 1 double crochet, 7 treble, 1 double crochet into the next loop, 3 chain; repeat from beginning of row, but in making the 7 chain of the first triple picot loop the third stitch into the corresponding chain in the last triple picot of the previous section of the design, then continue as before described.

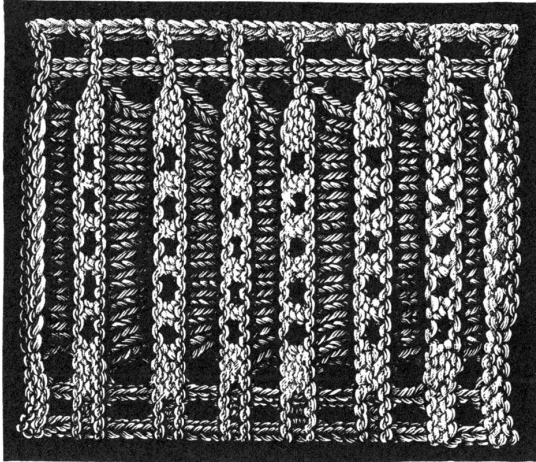
EDGING. FLUTED.

THIS insertion, knitted with Struts' knitting cotton No. 8 and steel needles No. 15, measures about 2½ inches in width. **1st row**—

Plain. **2nd row**—Knit 2 together, make 2, knit 2 together, knit 14, knit 2 together, make 2, knit 2 together. **3rd row**—Knit 2, purl 16, turn, knit 14. **4th row**—Purl 14, turn, knit 14. **5th row**—Like fourth row. **6th row**—Like fourth row, turn. **7th row**—Knit 16, purl 1, knit 1. **8th row**—Knit 4, purl 2, * make 1, purl 2 together, repeat from * four times, purl 2, knit 4. Repeat from the first row.

FLUTED LACE.

KNITTED in Strutts' knitting cotton No. 8 and steel needles No. 15, measures about 2½ inches in depth. Cast on 24 stitches. **1st row**—Knit 2, purl 16, knit 3, make 1, knit 2 together, knit 1. **2nd row**—Knit 3, make 1, knit 2 together, knit 1, * knit 2 together, make 1, repeat from * six times, knit 2, make 1, knit 2 together. **3rd row**—Knit 2, purl 16, knit 3, make 1, knit 2 together, knit 1. **4th row**—Knit 3, make 1, knit 2 together, knit 1, purl 16, make 1, knit 2 together. **5th row**—* Knit 18, turn, purl 16, make 1, knit 2 together, turn, repeat from * three times. Repeat from the first row.

HECUBA LACE.

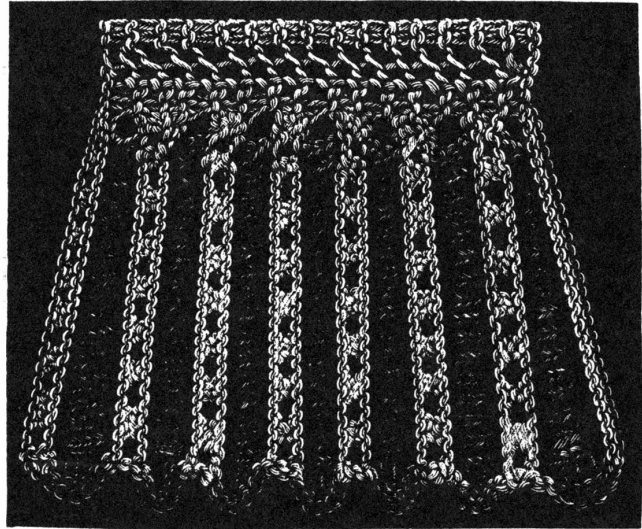
A PRETTY and simple lace, which looks equally well in coarse or fine cotton. Worked with No. 10 knitting cotton and steel needles No. 17, its greatest depth is about two inches; with No. 6 cotton and needles No. 14, it is about three inches deep.

Cast on twenty stitches—**1st row**—Knit 3, make 1, purl 2 together, * slip 1 the purl way, purl 1, repeat from * six times, slip 1 the purl way. **2nd row**—Purl 17, make 1, purl 2 together, purl 1. **3rd row**—Knit 3, make 1, knit 2 together, purl 1, * slip 1 the purl way, purl 1, repeat from * six times. **4th row**—Same as the second. **5th row**—Same as the first. **6th row**—Same as the second. **7th row**—Same as the third. **8th row**—Same as the second. **9th row**—Knit 3, make 1, knit 2 together, knit 13, make 1, knit 2. **10th row**—Purl 18, make 1, purl 2 together, purl 1. **11th row**—Knit 3, make 1, knit 2 together, knit 14, make 1, knit 2. **12th row**—Purl 19, make 1, purl 2 together, purl 1. **13th row**—Knit 3, make 1, knit 2 together, knit 15, make 1, knit 2. **14th row**—Purl 20, make 1, purl 2 together, purl 1. **15th row**—Knit 3, * make 1, knit 2 together, repeat from * seven times, knit 2, make 1, knit 2. **16th row**—Purl 21, make 1, purl 2 together, purl 1. **17th row**—Knit 3, make 1, knit 2 together, knit 1, * make 1, knit 2 together, repeat from * six times, knit 2 together, make 1, knit 2. **18th row**—Purl 21, make 1, purl 2 together, purl 1. **19th row**—Knit 3, * make 1, knit 2 together, repeat from * seven times, slip 1, knit 2 together, draw the slipped stitch over, make 1, knit 2. **20th row**—Purl 20, make 1, purl 2 together, purl 1. **21st row**—Knit 3, make 1, knit 2 together, knit 12, knit 2 together, knit 2 together, make 1, knit 2. **22nd row**—Purl 19, make 1, purl 2 together, purl 1. **23rd row**—Knit 3, make 1, knit 2 together, knit 11, knit 2 together, knit 2 together, make 1, knit 2. **24th row**—Purl 18, make 1, purl 2 together, purl 1. **25th row**—Knit 3, make 1, knit 2 together, knit 10, knit 2 together, knit 2 together, make 1, knit 2. **26th row**—Purl 17, make 1, purl 2 together, purl 1. Repeat from the first row.

GREEK PATTERN INSERTION.

THIS pattern, worked with Strutts' knitting cotton No. 8 and steel pins No. 16, measures about 4½ inches in width, and is suited for using with the Greek pattern lace on page 4. Cast on forty-nine stitches. **1st row**—Knit 2, purl 1, knit 1, purl 1, knit 25, purl 1, knit 1, purl 1, knit 2, purl 7, knit 2, purl 1, knit 1, purl 1, knit 2. **2nd row**—Purl 2, knit 1, purl 1, purl 2, knit 7, purl 2, * knit 1, purl 1, repeat from * fourteen times, knit 1, purl 2. **3rd row**—Knit 1, * purl 1, knit 1, repeat from * sixteen times, purl 7, knit 1, * purl 1, knit 1, repeat from the last * twice. **4th row**—* Purl 1, knit 1, repeat from * twice, purl 1, knit 7, * purl 1, knit 1, repeat from the last * sixteen times, purl 1. **5th row**—Knit 2, * purl 1, knit 1, repeat from * fourteen times, purl 1, knit 2, purl 7, knit 2, purl 1, knit 1, purl 1, knit 2. **6th row**—Purl 2, knit 1, purl 1, knit 1, purl 2, knit 7, purl 28, knit 1, purl 1, knit 1, purl 1, knit 1, purl 2. **7th row**—Knit 1, * purl 1, knit 1, repeat from * twice, purl 35, knit 1, * purl 1, knit 1, repeat from the last * twice. **8th row**—* Purl 1, knit

1, repeat from * twice, purl 1, knit 35, * purl 1, knit 1, repeat from the last * twice, purl 1. **9th row**—Knit 2, purl 1, knit 1, purl 1, knit 2, purl 35, knit 2, purl 1, knit 1, purl 1, knit 2. **10th row**—Purl 2, knit 1, purl 1, knit 1, purl 2, knit 35, purl 2, knit 1, purl 1, purl 1, purl 2. **11th row**—Like seventh row. **12th row**—Like eighth row. **13th row**—Knit 2, purl 1, knit 1, purl 1, knit 2, purl 7, knit 30, purl 1, knit 1, purl 1, knit 2. **14th row**—Purl 2, * knit 1, purl 1, repeat from * fourteen times, knit 1, purl 2, knit 7, purl 2, knit 1, purl 1, knit 1, purl 2. **15th row**—Knit 1, * purl 1, knit 1, repeat from * twice, purl 7, * knit 1, purl 1, repeat from the last * sixteen times, knit 1. **16th row**—* Purl 1, knit 1, repeat from * sixteen times, purl 1, knit 7, * purl 1, knit 1, repeat from the last * twice, purl 1. **17th row**—Knit 2, purl 1, knit 1, purl 1, knit 2, purl 7, knit 2, * purl 1, knit 1, repeat from * fourteen times, purl 1, knit 2. **18th row**—Purl 2, knit 1, purl 1, knit 1, purl 25, knit 1, purl 1, knit 1, purl 2, knit 7, purl 2, knit 1, purl 1, knit 1, purl 2. **19th row**—* Knit 1, purl 1, repeat from * twice, knit 1, purl 7, * knit 1, purl 1, repeat from the last * twice, knit 1, purl 21, * knit 1, purl 1, repeat from the last * twice, knit 1. **20th row**—* Purl 1, knit 1, repeat from * twice, purl 1, knit 21, * purl 1, knit 1, repeat from the last * twice, purl 1, knit 7, * purl 1, knit 1, repeat from the last * twice, purl 1. **21st row**—Knit 2, purl 1, knit 1, purl 1, knit 2, purl 7, knit 2, purl 1, knit 1, purl 1, knit 2, purl 21, knit 2, purl 1, knit 1, purl 1, knit 2. **22nd row**—Purl 2, knit 1, purl 1, purl 2, knit 21, purl 2, knit 1, purl 1, knit 1, purl 2, knit 7, purl 2, knit 1, purl 1, knit 1, purl 2. **23rd row**—Like nineteenth row. **24th row**—Like twentieth row. **25th row**—* Knit 2, purl 1, knit 1, purl 1, knit 2, purl 7, repeat from * once, knit 7, purl 7, knit 2, purl 1, knit 1, purl 1, knit 2. **26th row**—* Purl 2, knit 1, purl 1, knit 1, purl 2, knit 7, repeat from * twice, purl 2, knit 1, purl 1, knit 1, purl 2. **27th row**—* Knit 1, purl 1, repeat from * twice, knit 1, purl 7, repeat from the first * twice, * knit 1, purl 1, repeat from the last * twice, knit 1. **28th row**—* Purl 1, knit 1, repeat from * twice, purl 1, knit 7, repeat from the first * twice, * purl 1, knit 1, repeat from the last * twice, purl 1. **29th row**—* Knit 2, purl 1, knit 1, purl 1, knit 2, purl 7, repeat from * twice, knit 2, purl 1, knit 1, purl 1, knit 2. **30th row**—* Purl 2, knit 1, purl 1, knit 1, purl 2, knit 7, repeat from * once, purl 7, knit 7, purl 2, knit 1, purl 1, knit 1, purl 2. **31st row**—* Knit 1, purl 1, repeat from * twice, knit 1, purl 21, (a) knit 1, purl 1, repeat from (a) twice, knit 1, purl 7, repeat from (a) to (a) three times, knit 1. **32nd row**—* Purl 1, knit 1, repeat from * twice, purl 1, knit 7, (a) purl 1, knit 1, repeat from (a) twice, purl 1, knit 21, repeat from (a) to (a) three times, purl 1. **33rd row**—Knit 2, purl 1, knit 1, purl 1, knit 2, purl 21, knit 2, purl 1, knit 1, purl 1, knit 2, purl 7, knit 2, purl 1, knit 1, purl 1, knit 2. **34th row**—Purl 2, knit 1, purl 1, knit 1, purl 2, knit 7, purl 2, knit 1, purl 1, purl 1, purl 2, knit 21, purl 2, knit 1, purl 1, knit 1, purl 2. **35th row**—Like thirty-first row. **36th row**—Like thirty-second row. Repeat from the first row.

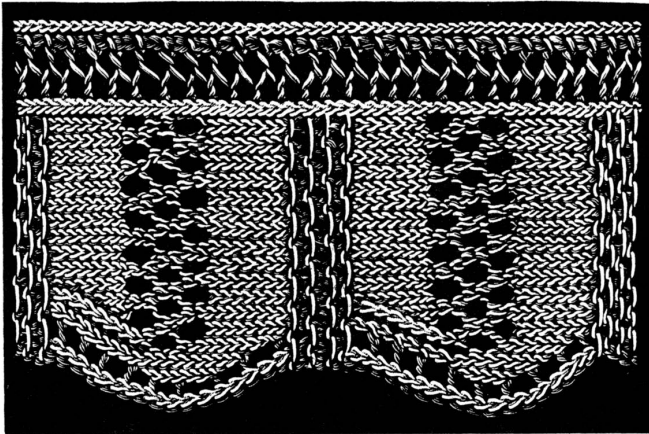


Fluted Lace.

SHIRLEY LACE.

AN exceedingly handsome edging, suitable for bordering quilts or counterpanes, toilet-covers, &c. It looks well knitted in No. 10 knitting cotton (Strutts') with steel needles No. 17. Its greatest width is then about 3½ inches. Cast on 24 stitches. **1st row**—Knit 2, make 2, knit 2 together, knit 1, purl 3, increase 2 by working knit 1, purl 1, knit 1 in the same stitch, purl 3, * make 1, knit 2 together, repeat from * four times, make 1, knit 2. **2nd row**—Knit 16, purl 3, knit 3, purl 5, dropping one of the two made stitches. **3rd row**—Knit 2, make 2, knit 2 together, knit 1, purl 3, knit 1, make 1, knit 1, make 1, knit 1, purl 4, * make 1, knit 2 together, repeat from * four times, make 1, knit 2. **4th row**—Knit 17, purl 5, knit 3, purl 5, dropping one of the two made stitches. **5th row**—Knit 2, make 2, knit 2 together, knit 1, purl 3, knit 2, make 1, knit 1, make 1, knit 2, purl 5, * make 1, knit 2 together, repeat from * four times, make 1, knit 2. **6th row**—Knit 18, purl 7, knit 3, purl 5, dropping one of the two made stitches. **7th row**—Knit 2, make 2, knit 2 together, knit 1, purl 3, knit 2 together, knit 1, purl 2 together, purl 6, * make 1, knit 2 together; repeat from * four times, make 1, knit 2. **8th**

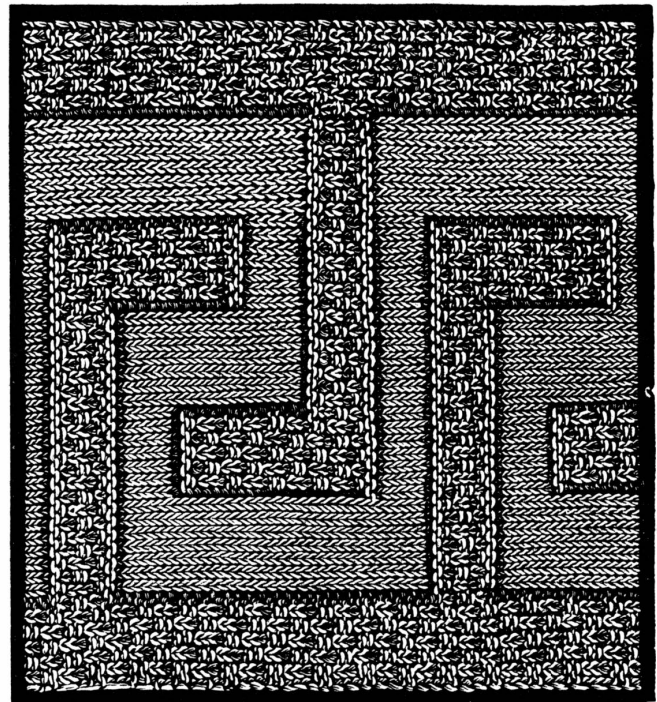
row—Knit 19, purl 5, knit 3, purl 5, dropping one of the two made stitches. **9th row**—Knit 2, make 2, knit 2 together, knit 1, purl 3, knit 2 together, knit 1, knit 2 together, purl 3, increase 2 by working knit 1, purl 1, knit 1 in the same stitch, purl 3, * make 1, knit 2 together, repeat from * four times, make 1, knit 2. **10th row**—Knit 16, purl 3, knit 3, purl 3; knit 3, purl 5, dropping one of the two made stitches. **11th row**—Knit 2, make 2, knit 2 together, knit 1, purl 3, knit 3 together, purl 3, knit 1, make 1, knit 1, make 1, knit 1, purl 4, * make 1, knit 2 together; repeat from * four times, make 1, knit 2. **12th row**—Knit 17, purl 5, knit 7, purl 5, dropping one of the two made stitches. **13th row**—Knit 2, make 2, knit 2 together, knit 1, purl 7, knit 2, make 1, knit 1, make 1, knit 2, purl 5, * make 1, knit 2 together, repeat from * four times, make 1, knit 2. **14th row**—Knit 18, purl 7, knit 7, purl 5, dropping one of the two made stitches. **15th row**—Knit 2, make 2, knit 2 together, knit 1, purl 7, knit 2 together, knit 3, knit 2 together, purl 6, * make 1, knit 2 together, repeat from * four times make 1, knit 2. **16th row**—Knit 19, purl 5, knit 7, purl 5, dropping one of

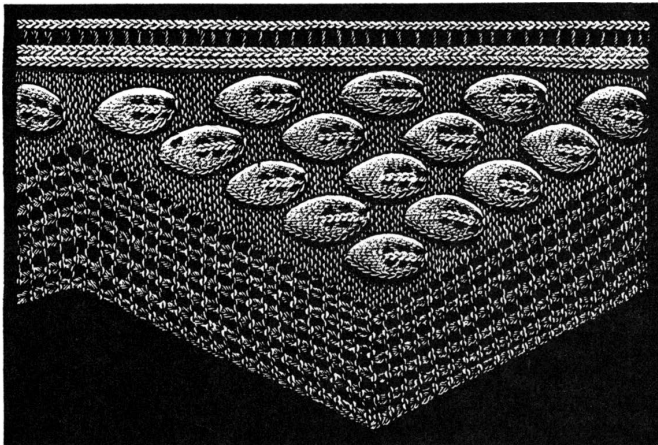

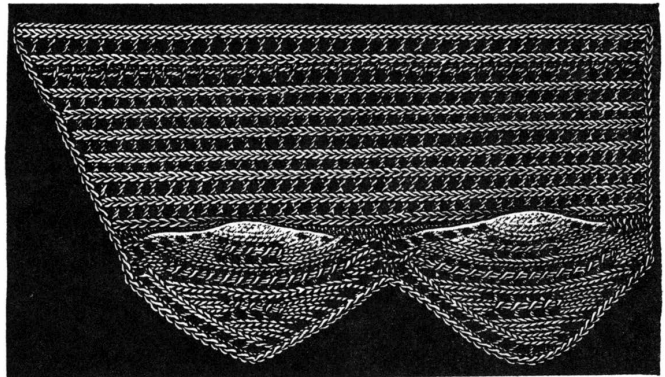

COURTENAY LACE.

THIS pattern looks best in fine cotton, and is very well suited for knitting in ivory (crochet) cotton as a trimming for canvas embroidery. It also looks well worked in fine Strutt's knitting cotton, No 10 with steel pins No. 15. Its greatest depth is then about 3 1/2 inches. Cast on 24 stitches. **1st row**—Knit 2, make 1, knit 2 together, purl 1, * make 1, knit 2 together, repeat from * six times, * purl 2, make 1, knit 1, make 1, purl 2. **2nd row**—Knit 2, purl 3, knit 2, purl 19. **3rd row**—Work as far as the *third* * in the first row, then purl 2, make 1, knit 3, make 1, purl 2. **4th row**—Knit 2, purl 5, knit 2, purl 19. **5th row**—Work as before to the *third* * in first row, then purl 2, make 1, knit 5, make 1, purl 2. **6th row**—Knit 2, purl 7, knit 2, purl 19. **7th row**—Work heading as usual, then purl 2, make 1, knit 2, make 1, slip 1, knit 2 together, pull the slipped stitch over (thus decreasing 2), make 1, knit 2, make 1, purl 2. **8th row**—Knit 2, purl 9, knit 2, purl 19. **9th row**—As before then—purl 2, make 1, knit 3, make 1, decrease 2 (as before), make 1, knit 3, make 1, purl 2. **10th row**—Knit 2, purl 11, knit 2, purl 19. **11th row**—As before, then—purl 2, make 1, knit 4, make 1, decrease 2, rake 1, knit 4, make 1, purl 2. **12th row**—Knit 2, purl 13, knit 2, purl 19. **13th row**—As before, then—purl 2, make 1, knit 5, make 1, decrease 2, make 1, knit 5, make 1, purl 2. **14th row**—Knit 2, purl 15, knit 2, purl 19. **15th row**—As before, then—purl 2, make 1, knit 2, make 1, decrease 2, make 1, knit 1, make 1, decrease 2, make 1, knit 1, make 1, decrease 2, make 1, knit 2, make 1, purl 2. **16th row**—Knit 2, purl 17, knit 2, purl 19. **17th row**—As before, then—purl 2, make 1, knit 3, make 1, decrease 2, make 1, knit 1, make 1, decrease 2, make 1, knit 1, make 1, decrease 2, make 1, knit 3, make 1, purl 2. **18th row**—Knit 2, purl 19, knit 2, purl 19. **19th row**—As before, then—purl 1, purl 2 together, make 1, knit 3, make 1, decrease 2, make 1, knit 1, make 1, decrease 2, make 1, knit 1, make 1, decrease 2, make 1, knit 3, make 1,

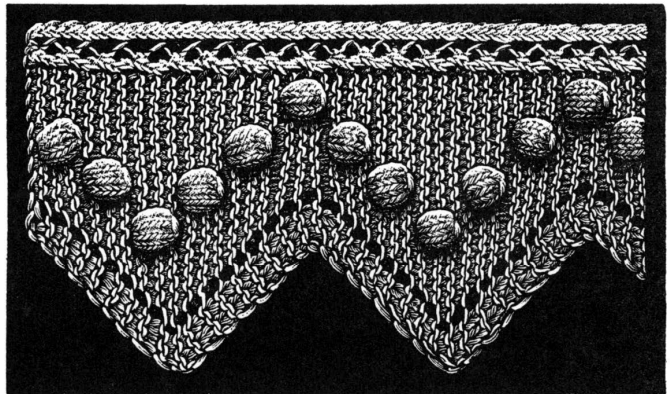

HOLLY EDGING.

Most effective when knitted with moderately coarse cotton and needles. Worked with Strutt's white knitting cotton No. 8 and steel needles No. 14, its greatest depth is about three inches. Cast on 16 stitches. **1st row**—Make 1, knit 1, knit 2 together, make 1, knit 9, knit 2 together, make 1, knit 2. **2nd**

row—Purl 4, knit 13. **3rd row**—Make 1, knit 1, knit 2 together, make 1, knit 11, make 1, knit 2 together, knit 1. **4th row**—Purl 4, knit 14. **5th row**—Make 1, knit 1, knit 2 together, make 1, knit 5, 1 tuft (each tuft is made thus: Knit 3 in 1, turn, make 1, purl the three just knitted, turn, make 1, knit 4, turn, purl 5, turn, knit 2 together, knit 1, knit 2 together, turn, purl 3, turn, slip 1, knit 2 together, pull the slipped stitch over), knit 5, knit 2 together, make 1, knit 2. **6th row**—Purl 4, knit 15. **7th row**—Make 1, knit 1, knit 2 together, make 1, knit 13, make 1, knit 2 together, knit 1. **8th row**—Purl 4, knit 16. **9th row**—Make 1, knit 1, knit 2 together, make 1, knit 13, knit 2 together, make 1, knit 2. **10th row**—Purl 4, knit 17. **11th row**—Make 1, knit 1, knit 2 together, make 1, knit 5, 1 tuft, knit 9, make 1, knit 2 together, knit 1. **12th row**—Purl 4, knit 18. **13th row**—Make 1,

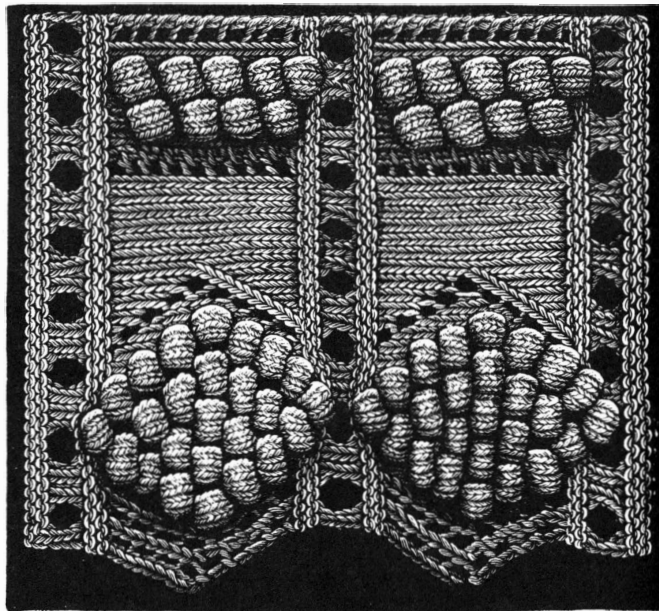
WEDGE INSERTION.

An exceedingly pretty yet simple insertion; in Strutt's knitting cotton No. 6, and steel needles No. 14, its width is about three inches. Cast on twenty-nine stitches. **1st row**—Purl. **2nd row**—Plain. **3rd row**—Purl 3, * knit 2 together five times, putting cotton twice round needle each time so as to make two stitches, not one; purl 3, and repeat from *. **4th row**—Knit 3, * knit 1 and purl 1 five times alternately in the double stitches of the last row, knit 3, repeat from *. **5th row**—Purl 3, knit 1, knit 2 together four times, putting cotton twice round needle as before; purl 5, knit 2 together four times, putting cotton twice round needle as before, knit 1, purl 3. **6th row**—Knit 4, knit 1 and purl 1 four times alternately in the double stitches of the last row, knit 5, knit 1 and purl 1 four times alternately in the double stitches of last row, knit 4. **7th row**—Purl 3, knit 2 together four times, putting cotton twice round needle as before, purl 7, knit 2 together four times, putting cotton twice round needle as before, purl 3. **8th row**—Knit 3, knit 1 and purl 1 four times alternately in the double stitches of last row, knit 7, knit 1 and purl 1 four times alternately in double stitches of last row, knit 3. **9th row**—Purl 3, knit 1, knit 2 together three times, putting cotton twice round needle as before, purl 9, knit 2 together three times, putting cotton twice round needle as before, knit 1, purl 3. **10th row**—Knit 4, knit 1 and purl 1 three times alternately, knit 9, knit 1 and purl 1 three times alternately, knit 4. **11th row**—Purl 3, knit 2 together three times, putting cotton twice round needle, purl 11, knit 2 together three times, putting cotton twice round needle, purl 3. **12th row**—Knit 3, knit 1 and purl 1 three times alternately, knit 11, knit 1 and purl 1 alternately three times, knit 3. **13th row**—Purl 3, knit 1, knit 2 together, knit 2 together (always putting cotton twice round needle), purl 13, knit 2 together, knit 2 together (cotton twice round needle), knit 1, purl 3. **14th row**—Knit 5, purl 1, knit 1, purl 1, knit 14, purl 1, knit 1, purl 1, knit 4. **15th row**—Purl 3, knit 2 together, knit 2 together (as

before), purl 15, knit 2 together, knit 2 together (as before), purl 3. **16th row**—Knit 4, purl 1, knit 1, purl 1, knit 16, purl 1, knit 1, purl 1, knit 3. **17th row**—Purl 3, knit 1, knit 2 together (in usual way), purl 17, knit 2 together (in usual way), knit 1, purl 3. **18th row**—Knit 5, purl 1, knit 18, purl 1, knit 4. **19th row**—Purl 3, knit 2 together (as usual), purl 19, knit 2 together (as usual), purl 3. **20th row**—Knit 4, purl 1, knit 20, purl 1, knit 3. Repeat from first row. It will be seen by the illustration that by way of variety and enrichment a little embroidery has been introduced into one section of this pattern; which, however, is quite complete without it. Workers who think the addition of the stitchery an improvement will notice that the small blocks in the design consist each of three straight horizontal stitches taken over two ribs of the knitting and caught together with an upright stitch. Two ribs of the knitting are left between the small blocks. At the bottom of the triangle is a single small block, then two ribs are missed and a block taken over four and a half ribs of the knitting and caught together with three vertical stitches instead of one stitch in the middle. Up the sides of the triangle is now to be worked a set of back-stitches. Each of these stitches is taken through the small holes that border the triangle and over the raised ribs, which run horizontally across the triangle. This embroidery, worked in red ingrain knitting cotton on a white ground, adds greatly to the beauty of the work.

FIR-CONE LACE.

THE clusters of tufts which border this design somewhat resemble fir-cones. Worked in Strutt's knitting cotton No. 8 and steel needles No. 15, its greatest depth is four inches. 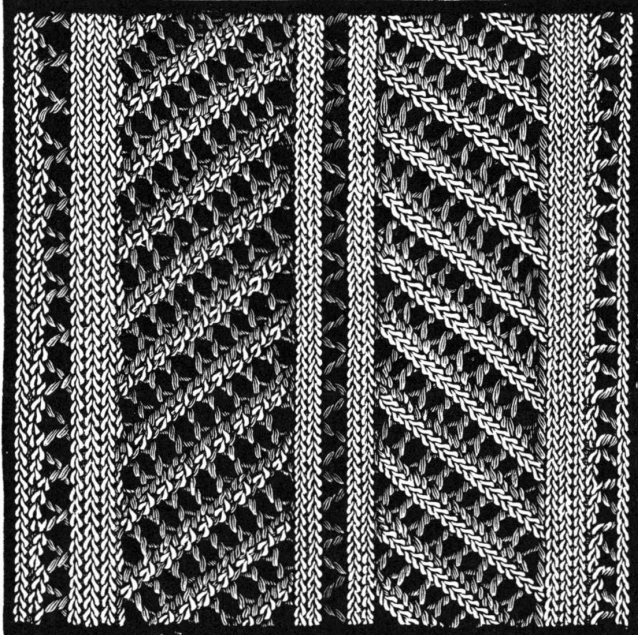

FISHBONE PATTERN INSERTION.

THIS pattern looks well worked in wool for trimming shawls, underwear, &c. The sizes of wool and needles must depend upon the article to be trimmed. This lace also works out well in coarse crochet or fine knitting cotton as a finish for sham towels, bedspreads, d'oyleys, &c. Knitted with undyed

mending wool, and steel needles No. 18, it measures $3\frac{1}{4}$ inches in width. 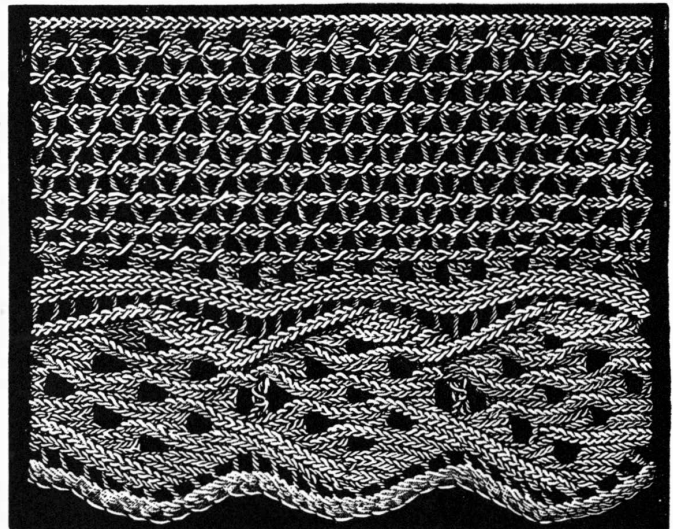

VERY NARROW LACE.

SUITABLE for edging pincushions, toilet mats, &c., and is quite a narrow edging, its extreme depth, knitted in coarse (Strutts' No. 6) knitting cotton and needles No. 16, being scarcely one inch, our illustration giving it enlarged to show distinctly its effective pattern. Cast on 7 stitches. **1st row**—Slip 1, purl 2, make 1, purl 2 together, make 2, purl 2 together. **2nd row**—Make 1, knit 2, purl 1, knit 2, make 1, knit 2 together, knit 1. **3rd row**—Slip 1, purl 2, make 1, purl 2 together, purl 4. **4th row**—Cast off 2, knit 3, make 1, knit 2 together, knit 1. Repeat from first row for the length required.

SYBIL LACE.

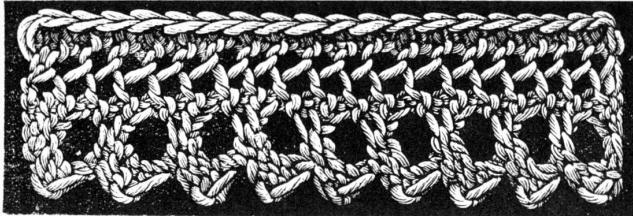
A HANDSOME lace for bordering large pieces of work, and the materials required are Strutts' knitting cotton No. 10, steel knitting needles No. 17, and a steel crochet hook No. 14. The greatest width of the lace (including the picot) is about $8\frac{1}{2}$ inches. 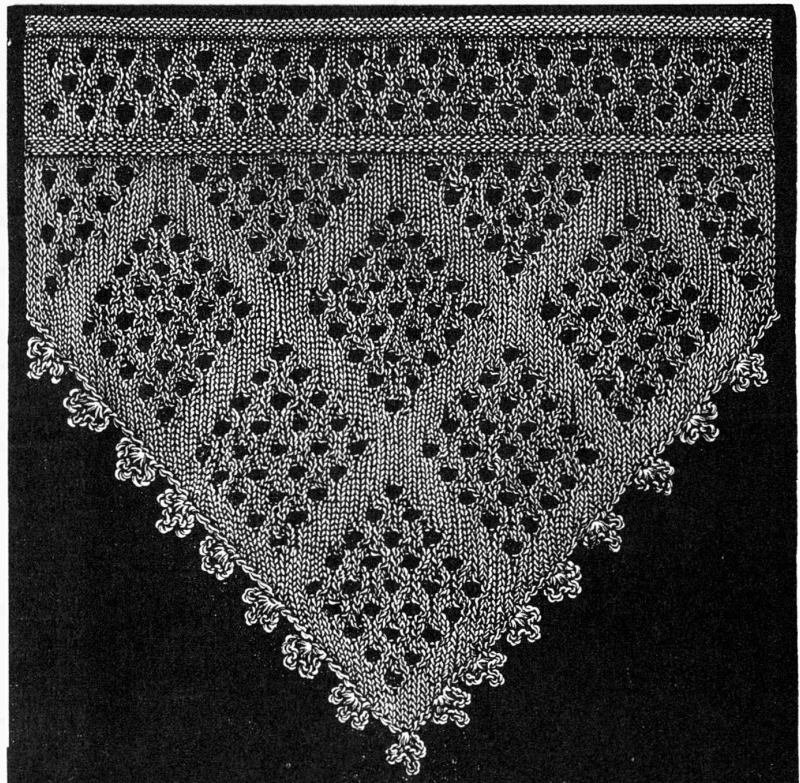

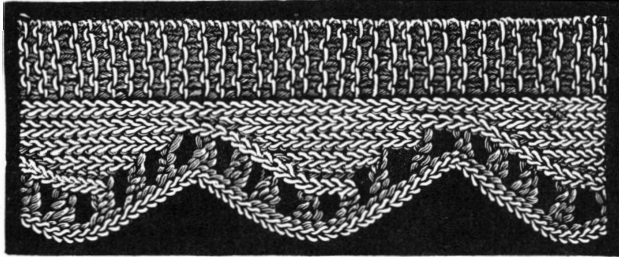

Cast off. This pattern is much improved by the narrow edging of crochet round it, which is made as follows: Begin by working 1 double crochet at the top of one side of a vandyke, then 5 chain, 1 double crochet into the first double crochet, 5 chain, 1 double crochet into the same stitch, and again 5 chain, 1 double crochet, * 5 double crochet into the edge of the vandyke, 5 chain, and 1 double crochet three times alternately into the fifth double crochet, repeat from * till there are eight sets of these loops down the side of the vandyke, make three loops exactly in the tip of the point and eight sets up the second side to correspond with the first. Continue thus along the whole length of the lace. If considered an improvement baby ribbon can be threaded in and out the three rows of holes, which form the top of this lace.

DORINDA EDGING.

A SIMPLE edging with one straight edge, from which the scallops hang slightly full, so that if the lace be carried round any d'oyley or pincushion cover it will not be found necessary to gather it. Knitted with Strutt's knitting cotton No. 10 and steel needles No. 17, its depth is about 1½ inches. Cast on 10 stitches. **1st row**—Purl. **2nd row**—* Purl 1, slip 1 the purl way, repeat from * twice, knit 2, make 2, knit 2 together. **3rd row**—Purl 2, knit 1, purl 8. **4th row**—* Slip 1 the purl way, purl 1, repeat from * twice, knit 5. **5th row**—Purl. **6th row**—* Purl 1, slip 1 the purl way, repeat from * twice, knit 3, make 2, knit 2 together. **7th row**—Purl 2, knit 1, purl 9. **8th row**—* Slip 1 the purl way, purl 1, repeat from * twice, knit 6. **9th row**—Purl. **10th row**—* Purl 1, slip 1 the purl way, repeat from * twice, knit 4, make 2, knit 2 together. **11th row**—Purl 2, knit 1, purl 10. **12th row**—* Slip 1 the purl way, purl 1, repeat from * twice, knit 7. **13th row**—Purl. **14th row**—* Purl 1, slip 1 the purl way, repeat from * twice, knit 5, make 2, knit 2 together. **15th row**—Purl 2, knit 1, purl 11. **16th row**—* Slip 1 the purl way, purl 1, repeat from * twice, knit 8. **17th row**—Purl 2 together, purl 12. **18th row**—* Purl 1, slip 1 the purl way, repeat from * twice, knit 3, knit 2 together, make 2, knit 2 together. **19th row**—Purl 2, knit 1, purl 10. **20th row**—* Slip 1 the purl way, purl 1, repeat from * twice, knit 7. **21st row**—Purl 2 together, purl 11. **22nd row**—* Purl 1, slip 1 the purl way, repeat from * twice, knit 2, knit 2 together, make 2, knit 2 together. **23rd row**—Purl 2, knit 1, purl 9. **24th row**—* Slip 1 the purl way, purl 1, repeat from * twice, knit 6. **25th row**—Purl 2 together, purl 10. **26th row**—* Purl 1, slip 1 the purl way, repeat from * twice, knit 1, knit 2 together, make 2, knit 2 together. **27th row**—Purl 2, knit 1, purl 8. **28th row**—* Slip 1 the purl way, purl 1, repeat from * twice, knit 5. **29th row**—Purl 2 together, purl 9. Repeat from the second row.

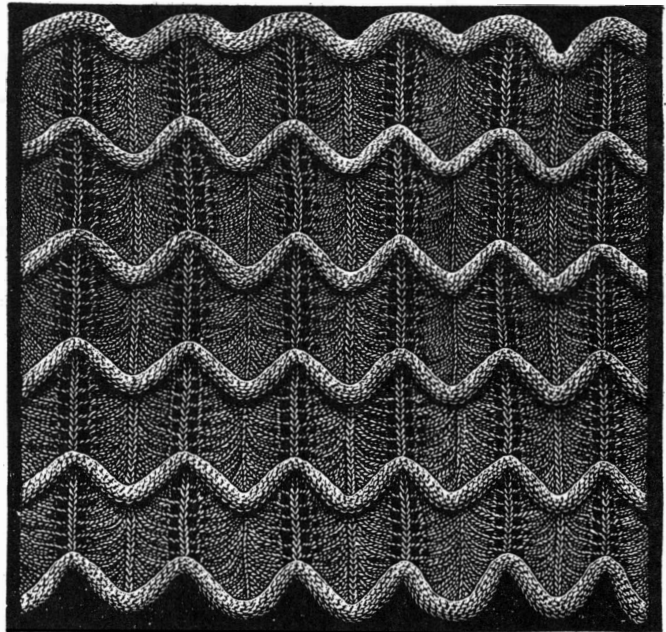
FEATHER PATTERN LACE.

To be knitted in strips for toilet-covers or quilts, or in shorter lengths, makes a pretty lace if the vandyked upper edge is not objected to. The model was

worked with Wheeler's ivory (crochet) cotton No. 16 and steel needles No. 17. Cast on any number of stitches that can be divided by 17, and knit—**1st row**—Plain. **2nd row**—Purl. **3rd row**—Plain. **4th row**—Knit 2 together, knit 2 together, knit 3, * make 1, knit 1, repeat from * twice, make 1, knit 3, knit 2 together, knit 2 together, repeat from the beginning of the row. **5th row**—Purl. Work the fourth and fifth rows six times more. **18th row**—Like fourth row. **19th row**—Plain. **20th row**—Purl. **21st row**—Plain. Repeat from the fourth row for the depth required. With the materials here named each repeat measures about an inch and a half. Much of the effectiveness of this pattern depends upon the neatness with which the sections of it are sewn together.

BELL PATTERN LACE IN TWO COLOURS.

A HANDSOME pattern appropriate for edging a bell-pattern counterpane or quilt, or for trimming toilet covers. Knitted in coarse wool with bone or coarse steel needles it makes an effective and raised bordering for a perambulator rug or sofa blanket. For a counterpane edging in No. 10 cotton and needles (steel) No. 15, its greatest depth is about 3½ inches. 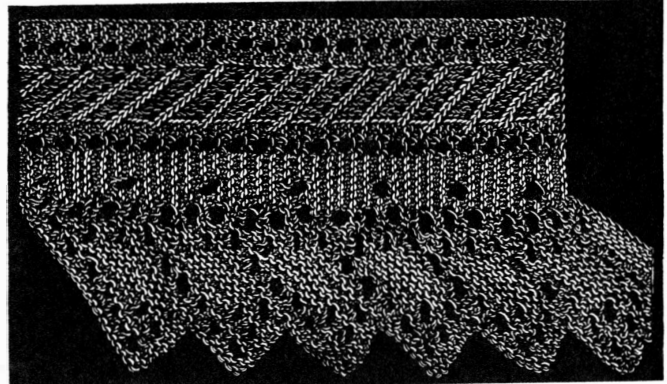

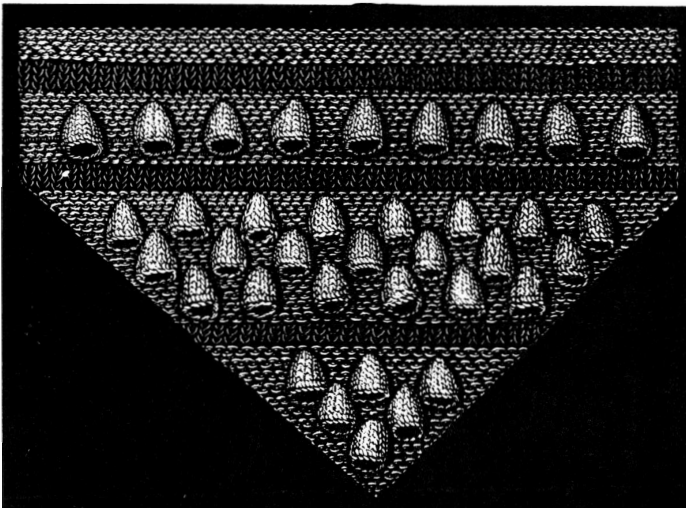
RIBBED PATTERN EDGING.

THE depth of this pattern, when worked with Strutt's knitting cotton No. 10 and steel pins No. 16, is about three inches. It will be found a pretty edging for toilet-covers or large doyleys. Cast on 24 stitches. **1st row**—Increase 1

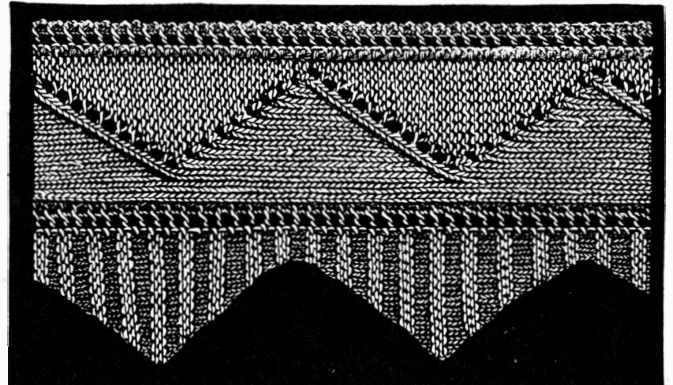


Bell Pattern Lace, in Two Colours.

SLANT PATTERN EDGING.

WORKED with Walter Evans' crochet cotton No. 4 and steel pins No. 18, this edging measures about four inches in depth. 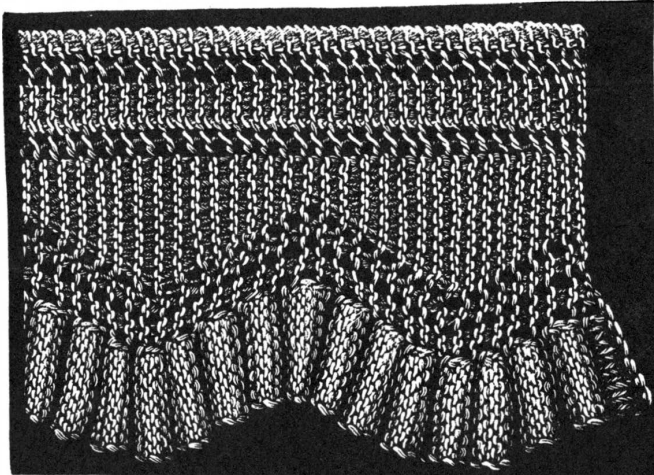


Ribbed Pattern Edging.

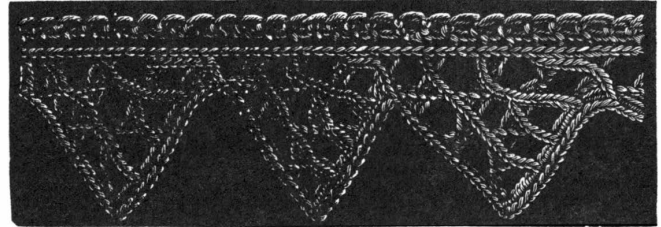

NARROW WOOLLEN LACE.

FOR trimming undyed flannel this lace works out well in darning wool, using fine steel pins, No. 17, 18, or 19. With the same-sized needles and coarse crochet cotton (such as Walter Evans' No. 12, or Ardern's No. 10), this lace is appropriate for use on under-linen, table-linen, &c., while in knitting cotton

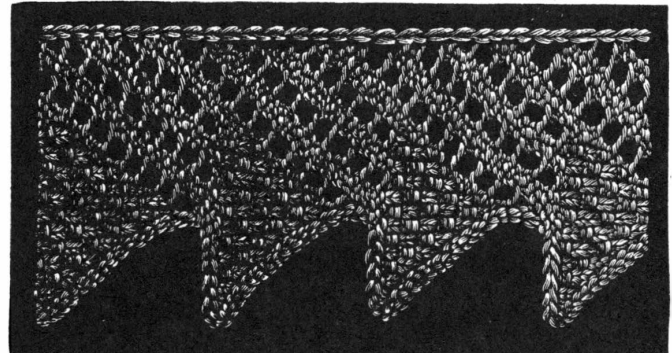


Narrow Woollen Lace.

No. 10 and steel needles No. 16 it is suited for edging toilet-covers, house-linen, &c. Cast on 7 stitches and knit 1 plain row. **2nd row**—Purl 1, make 1, purl 2 together, purl 1, make 2, purl 2 together, purl 1. **3rd row**—Knit 3, purl 1, knit 1, make 1, purl 2 together, purl 1. **4th row**—Purl 1, make 1, purl 2 together, purl 5. **5th row**—Knit 5, make 1, purl 2 together, purl 1. **6th row**—Purl 1, make 1, purl 2 together, purl 1, make 2, purl 2 together, make 2, purl 2 together. **7th row**—Knit 2, purl 1, knit 2, purl 1, knit 1, make 1, purl 2 together, purl 1. **8th row**—Purl 1, make 1, purl 2 together, purl 7. **9th row**—Knit 7, make 1, purl 2 together, purl 1. **10th row**—Purl 1, make 1, purl 2 together, purl 1, * make 2, purl 2 together, repeat from * twice. **11th row**—* Knit 2, purl 1, repeat from * five times, purl 1, purl 2 together, purl 1. **12th row**—Purl 1, make 1, purl 2 together, purl 10. **13th row**—Knit 10, make 1, purl 2 together, purl 1. **14th row**—Purl 1, make 1, purl 2 together, purl 2, * make 2, purl 2 together, repeat from * three times. **15th row**—* Knit 2, purl 1, repeat from * three times, knit 2, make 1, purl 2 together, purl 1. **16th row**—Purl 1, make 1, purl 2 together, purl 14. **17th row**—Cast off 10, knit 3, make 1, purl 2 together, purl 1. Repeat from the second row.

ATLAS LACE IN WOOL.

WORKED in undyed mending wool with steel needles No. 18, the greatest depth of this lace is about 1½ inches, and it is suited for edging shawls, underwear, &c., and it can also be knitted in cotton. Cast on 19 stitches. **1st row**—Purl. **2nd row**—Knit 1, make 1, knit 2 together, knit 1, make 1, knit 2 together, * purl 1, knit 1, repeat from * five times, purl 1. **3rd row**—* Knit 1, purl 1, repeat from * five times, knit 1, purl 6. **4th row**—Knit 2, make 1, knit 2 together, knit 1, make 1, knit 2 together, * purl 1, knit 1, repeat from * four times, purl 2 together. **5th row**—* Knit 1, purl 1, repeat from * four times, knit 1, purl 7. **6th row**—Knit 3, make 1, knit 2 together, knit 1, make 1, knit 2 together, * purl 1, knit 1, repeat from * three times, purl 2 together. **7th row**—* Knit 1, purl 1, repeat from * three times, knit 1, purl 8. **8th row**—Knit 1, make 1, knit 2 together, knit 1, make 1, knit 2 together, * purl 2 together, knit 1, make 1, knit 2 together, * purl 1, knit 1, repeat from * twice, purl 2 together. **9th row**—* Knit 1, purl 1, repeat from * twice, knit 1, purl 9. **10th row**—Knit 2, make 1, knit 2 together, knit 1, make 1, knit 2 together, knit 1, make 1, knit 2 together, purl 1, knit 1, purl 1, knit 1, purl 2 together. **11th row**—Knit 1, purl 1, knit 1, purl 1, knit 1, purl 10. **12th row**—Knit 3, make 1, knit 2 together, knit 1, make 1, knit 2 together, knit 1, make 1, knit 2 together, knit 1, make 1, knit 2 together, purl 1, knit 1, purl 2 together. **13th row**—Knit 1, purl 1, knit 1,

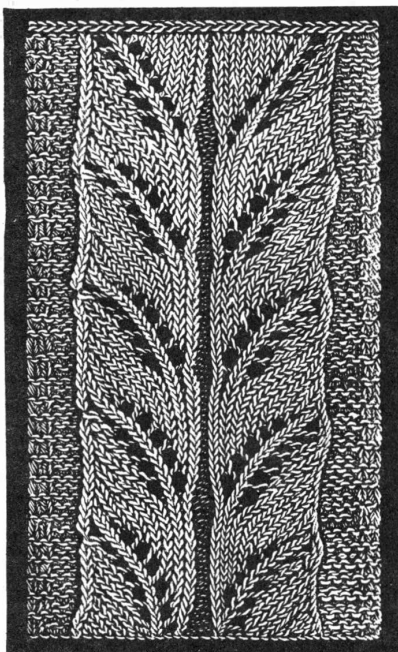


Atlas Lace in Wool.

purl 11. **14th row**—Knit 1, * make 1, knit 2 together, knit 1, repeat from * twice, make 1, knit 2 together, purl 2 together. **15th row**—Knit 1, purl 12. **16th row**—Knit 2, * make 1, knit 2 together, knit 1, repeat from * twice, make 1, knit 2 together. **17th row**—Purl. **18th row**—Knit 3, make 1, knit 2 together, knit 1, make 1, knit 2 together, knit 1, make 1, knit 2 together, knit 2, cast on 6. Repeat from the first row. When a sufficient length of this lace has been worked, cast off after knitting the seventeenth row.

CORAL PATTERN.

This is an exceedingly simple yet effective design, suited either for an insertion or for joining in strips for a toilet cover or quilt. It looks best in moderately coarse cotton—No. 6, steel needles No. 14. Cast on twenty-nine stitches. **1st row**—Knit 2, purl 2, knit 2 together, knit 2 together, knit 4, make 1, knit 1, make 1, knit 1, purl 1, knit 1, make 1, knit 1, make 1, knit 4, knit 2 together, knit 2 together, purl 2, knit 2. **2nd row**—Knit 4, purl 10, knit 1, purl 10, knit 4. **3rd row**—Knit 2, purl 2, knit 2 together, knit 2 together, knit 3, make 1, knit 1, make 1, knit 2, purl 1, knit 2, make 1, knit 1, make 1, knit 3, knit 2 together, knit 2 together, purl 2, knit 2. **4th row**—Like second row. **5th row**—Knit 2, purl 2, knit 2 together, knit 2 together, knit 2, make 1, knit 1, make 1, knit 3, purl 1, knit 3, make 1, knit 1, make 1, knit 2 together, knit 2 together, purl 2, knit 2. **6th row**—Like second row. **7th row**—Knit 2, purl 2, knit 2 together, knit 2 together, knit 1, make 1, knit 1, make 1, knit 4, purl 1, knit 4, make 1, knit 1, make 1, knit 2 together, knit 2 together, purl 2, knit 2. **8th row**—Like second row. **9th row**—Knit 2, purl 2, knit 2 together, knit 2 together, make 1, knit 1, make 1, knit 5, purl 1, knit 5, make 1, knit 1, make 1, knit 2 together, knit 2 together, purl 2, knit 2. **10th row**—Like second row. **11th row**—Knit 2, purl 2, slip 1, knit 2 together, pull the slipped stitch over, make 1, knit 1, make 1, knit 6, purl 1, knit 6, make 1, knit 1, make 1, slip 1, knit 2 together, pull the slipped stitch over, purl 2, knit 2. **12th row**—Like second row. Repeat from first row for the length required. The width of this design in the sizes of cotton and needles mentioned above is about three inches; the length of each repeat about one and a quarter inches.



Coral Pattern.

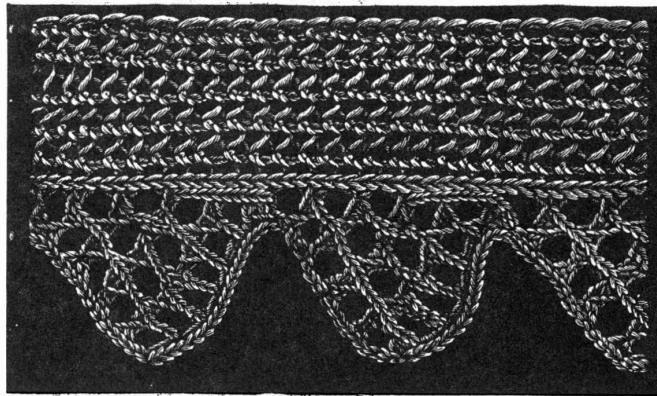
WOOLLEN LACE.

This edging looks well worked in undyed mending wool, coarse crochet cotton, or knitting cotton, according to the article which it is intended to trim. As a slight guide to the worker we may add that the depth of this lace, when knitted with Strutt's cotton No. 8 and steel needles No. 14, is about four inches. Cast on 15 stitches and work—**1st row**—Plain. **2nd row**—Purl 1, * make 1, purl 2 together, repeat from * four times, purl 1, make 2, purl 2 together, purl 1. **3rd row**—Knit 3, purl 1, knit 1, * make 1, purl 2 together, repeat from * four times, purl 1. **4th row**—Purl 1, * make 1, purl 2 together, repeat from * four times, purl 5. **5th row**—Knit 5, * make 1, purl 2 together, repeat from * four times, purl 1. **6th row**—Purl 1, * make 1, purl 2 together, repeat from * four times, purl 1, make 2, purl 2 together, make 2, purl 2 together. **7th row**—Knit 2, purl 1, knit 2, purl 1, knit 1, * make 1, purl 2 together, repeat from * four times, purl 1. **8th row**—Purl 1, * make 1, purl 2 together, repeat from * four times, purl 7. **9th row**—Knit 7, * make 1, purl 2 together, repeat from * four times, purl 1. **10th row**—Purl 1, * make 1, purl 2 together, repeat from * four times, purl 1, * make 2, purl 2 together, repeat from the last * twice. **11th row**—* Knit 2, purl 1, repeat from * twice, knit 1, * make 1, purl 2 together, repeat from the last * four times, purl 1. **12th row**—Purl 1, * make 1, purl 2 together, repeat from * four times, purl 10. **13th row**—Knit 10, * make 1, purl 2 together, repeat from * four times, purl 1. **14th row**—Purl 1, * make 1, purl 2 together, repeat from * four times, purl 2, * make 2, purl 2 together, repeat from the last * three times. **15th row**—* Knit 2, purl 1, repeat from * three times, knit 2, * make 1, purl 2 together, repeat from the last * four times, purl 1. **16th row**—Purl 1, * make 1, purl 2 together, repeat from * four times, purl 14. **17th row**—Knit 14, * make 1, purl 2 together, repeat from * four times, purl 1. **18th row**—Purl 1, * make 1,

purl 2 together, repeat from * four times, purl 2, * make 2, purl 2 together, repeat from the last * five times. **19th row**—* Knit 2, purl 1, repeat from * five times, knit 2, * make 1, purl 2 together, repeat from the last * four times, purl 1. **20th row**—Purl 1, * make 1, purl 2 together, repeat from * four times, purl 20. **21st row**—Cast off 16, knit 3, * make 1, purl 2 together, repeat from * four times, purl 1. Repeat from the second row.

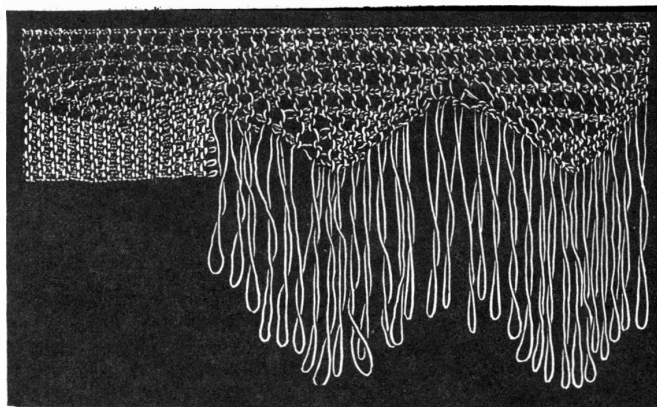
FRINGE IN VANDYKES.

SUITED to trimming household articles, such as d'oyles, toilet-mats, or small tea-cloths, and can be knitted in any preferred make and size of cotton. The model was worked with Wheeler's ivory (crochet) cotton No. 16, steel

pins No. 17, and when unravelled measured about three inches in its greatest depth. Cast on 12 stitches. **1st row**—Slip 1, knit 11. **2nd row**—Knit 7, make 1, knit 1, make 1, knit 2 together, make 1, knit 2 together. **3rd row**—Slip 1, knit 12. **4th row**—Knit 7, make 1, knit 2, make 1, knit 2 together, make 1, knit 2 together. **5th row**—Slip 1, knit 13. **6th row**—Knit 7, make 1, knit 1, * make 1, knit 2 together, repeat from * twice. **7th row**—Slip 1, knit 14. **8th row**—Knit 7, make 1, knit 2, * make 1, knit 2 together, repeat from * twice. **9th row**—Slip 1, knit 15. **10th row**—Knit 7, make 1, knit 1, * make 1, knit 2 together, repeat from * three times. **11th row**—Slip 1, knit 16. **12th row**—Knit 7, knit 2, * make 1, knit 2 together, repeat from * three times. **13th row**—Slip 1, knit 17. **14th row**—Knit 7, make 1, knit 1, * make 1, knit 2 together, repeat from * four times. **15th row**—Slip 1, knit 18. **16th row**—Knit 7, make 1, knit 2, * make 1, knit 2 together, repeat from * four times. **17th row**—Slip 1, knit 19. **18th row**—Knit 7, knit 2 together, knit 1, * make 1, knit 2 together, repeat from * four times. **19th row**—Slip 1, knit 18. **20th row**—Knit 7, knit 2 together,

* make 1, knit 2 together, repeat from * four times. **21st row**—Slip 1, knit 17. **22nd row**—Knit 7, knit 2 together, knit 1, * make 1, knit 2 together, repeat from * three times. **23rd row**—Slip 1, knit 16. **24th row**—Knit 7, knit 2 together, * make 1, knit 2 together, repeat from * three times. **25th row**—Slip 1, knit 15. **26th row**—Knit 7, knit 2 together, knit 1, * make 1, knit 2 together, repeat from * twice. **27th row**—Slip 1, knit 14. **28th row**—Knit 7, knit 2 together, * make 1, knit 2 together, repeat from * twice. **29th row**—Slip 1, knit 13. **30th row**—Knit 7, knit 2 together, knit 1, make 1, knit 2 together, make 1, knit 2 together. **31st row**—Slip 1, knit 12. **32nd row**—Knit 7, knit 2 together, make 1, knit 2 together, make 1, knit 2 together. Repeat from first row. When a sufficient length has been worked cast off 6 stitches and drop the remaining 6; the fringe is made by unravelling these stitches along the length of the lace. By working six, five, or four instead of seven edge stitches a narrower fringe can be obtained.
