

Majestic Beauty Runner

MALYNDA ALLEN

STRUCTURE

Overshot-patterned doubleweave.

EQUIPMENT

4-shaft loom, 18" weaving width; 10-dent reed; 2 shuttles; 2-4 bobbins; one piece of cardstock or cardboard 2" × 20" to serve as a space holder. Note: Tape two pieces of 1" or 2" cardstock or cardboard together to get the length you need.

YARNS

Warp: 10/2 unmercerized cotton (4,200 yd/lb; Georgia Yarn Company), #41 Carolina Blue and #30 Silver, 1,040 yd each; #32 Cherry Red and #37 Orchid, 203 yd

Weft: 10/2 unmercerized cotton, #29 Purple, 818 yd; #37 Orchid, 813 yd; #32 Cherry Red and #36 Hyacinth Violet, 32 yd each.

OTHER SUPPLIES

Rotary cutter; self-healing mat; ruler.

WARP LENGTH

710 ends 3½ vd long (allows 8" for take-up, 8" for sampling, 32" for loom waste; loom waste includes fringe). Add 21/4 yd to warp length to weave an additional runner.


SETTS

Warp: 40 epi (4/dent in a 10-dent reed; 20 epi per layer).

Weft: 40 ppi (20-21 per layer).

DIMENSIONS Width in reed: 17%/10". Woven lenath: (measured under tension on the loom) 78". Finished size: (after wetfinishing) one runner, 671/2" × 151/4" plus 11/2" fringe.

Weaving the runner: Please refer to the instructions for weaving the Majestic Beauty Placemats on pages 50-52 of Handwoven, January/ February 2022. Use the runner heddle count, the warp color order in Figure 1, and the draft in Figure 2 provided in this document. Insert the 2" space holder between the scrap yarn header and the runner at the beginning and at the end. Trim the fringe to 1½".
