

Color Nuggets Towels

VÉRONIQUE PERROT | HANDWOVEN SUMMER 2026 | ALTERNATE WARP COLOR ORDER

Note: This is an alternate way of winding the warp for the Color Nuggets Towels. It is meant for use in place of the Warp Color Order provided in Figure 1 in the *Handwoven Summer 2026* print edition, pages 22–26.

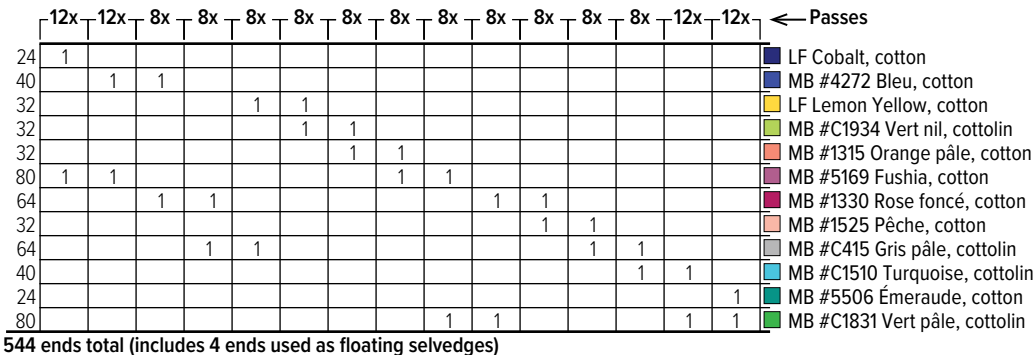
Warping Tips

Winding the warp. This warp is made of paired 8-end stripes: 3 pairs of Vert pâle and Émeraude, then 3 pairs of Vert pâle and Turquoise, then 2 pairs of Gris pâle and Turquoise, and so on. You can wind the warp as described in the warp color order in Figure 1 in the print issue, or you can wind the warp with an end of each color of the pair in hand following the alternate warp color order shown below in Figure 1a (Véronique calls this a mixed warp), and rearrange the ends in pairs of 8-end stripes when dressing the loom.

(Véronique wrote about this technique for efficiently winding warps in *Handwoven*, Spring 2024, “Warp Speed: Winding Warps with Multiple Ends in Hand,” page 26.)

Rearranging the ends. If you dress your loom from back to front, beam the mixed warp as is and reorder the ends when threading the heddles, following the warp color order in Figure 1. If you dress your loom from front to back, reorder the ends when you sley the reed. Beam the warp carefully, monitoring for tangles and giving a good tug on the warp when they happen.

544 ends total (includes 4 ends used as floating selvages)

Note: Each pass represents one full trip around the warping board or reel. One pass yields 4 ends—2 ends of each color.

LF = LoftyFiber
MB = Maurice Brassard
