ADOLESCENT HEALTH CENTER

Our Federally Qualified Health Center provides comprehensive care, including primary care, mental health services, sexual and reproductive care, vaccinations, dental and eye care, and health education.

2,483 young people received vital, age-appropriate health care



LEGAL SERVICES CENTER

Our dynamic legal team supports young people in civil legal matters with a focus on immigration, public benefits and housing, and family law concerns.

10,140 legal services provided



HOUSING & SUPPORTIVE SERVICES

Our drop-in center for those experiencing housing instability connects youth with immediate support and the ongoing resources to find housing and achieve self-sufficiency.

1,075 youth ages 16-24 accessed services from our Runaway & Homeless Youth Program



ARTS, RECREATION & NUTRITION

Our arts and community programming provides creative outlets, connection, and engagement, and our food and nutrition programs ensure that young people have access to healthy meals.

21,376 free delicious, nutritious meals and pantry bags were distributed



BROOME STREET ACADEMY

Our on-site SUNY-authorized charter high school reserves 50% of its incoming 9th-grade seats for students who are transitionally housed or in foster care and offers integrated supports in collaboration with The Door.

91% of 12th graders received a high school diploma **81%** of graduates were accepted to college



CAREER & EDUCATION

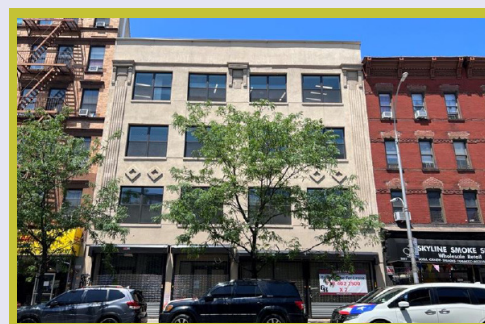
Our internship and job training programs partner with companies committed to developing long-term workforces. We also engage youth in high school equivalency (HSE) classes and college access programs.

A NEW BRONX YOUTH CENTER SPACE

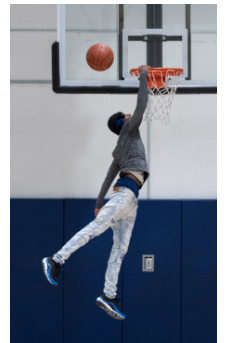

Merging the two previous smaller BYC facilities means The Door can increase its capacity to serve the Bronx community with expanded programming and services.
