ADOLESCENT HEALTH CENTER

Our Federally Qualified Health Center provides comprehensive care, including primary care, mental health services, sexual and reproductive care, vaccinations, dental and eye care, and health education.

39% of Door members utilize critical health and wellness services



LEGAL SERVICES CENTER

Our dynamic legal team supports young people in civil legal matters with a focus on immigration, public benefits and housing, and family law concerns.

18,000+ legal services provided



HOUSING & SUPPORTIVE SERVICES

Our drop-in center for those experiencing housing instability connects youth with immediate support and the ongoing resources to find housing and achieve self-sufficiency.

19,000+ services were accessed from our Supportive Housing and Runaway & Homeless Youth Programs



ARTS, RECREATION & NUTRITION

Our arts and community programming provides creative outlets, connection, and engagement, and our food and nutrition programs ensure that young people have access to healthy meals.

BROOME STREET ACADEMY

Our on-site SUNY-authorized charter high school reserves 50% of its incoming 9th-grade seats for students who are transitionally housed or in foster care and offers integrated supports in collaboration with The Door.



CAREER & EDUCATION

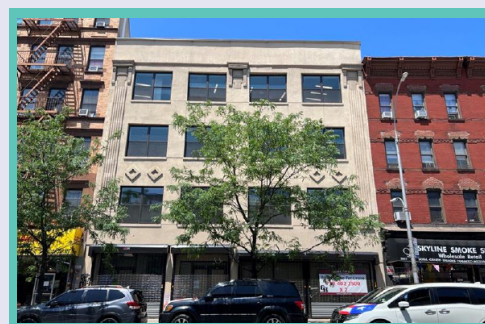
Our internship and job training programs partner with companies committed to developing long-term workforces. We also engage youth in high school equivalency (HSE) classes and college access programs.

BRONX YOUTH CENTER

The Door's Bronx Youth Center (BYC) offers a diverse and holistic services all in one place. Purpose-built to house the unique range of classrooms, and meeting and recreational space, including a 24-hour drop-in center.

Strategically located in the South Bronx, spans three stories of exposed brick and huge windows, sprawling over 18,000 square feet. Merging the two previous smaller BYC facilities means increased capacity to serve the Bronx community with expanded programming and services.
