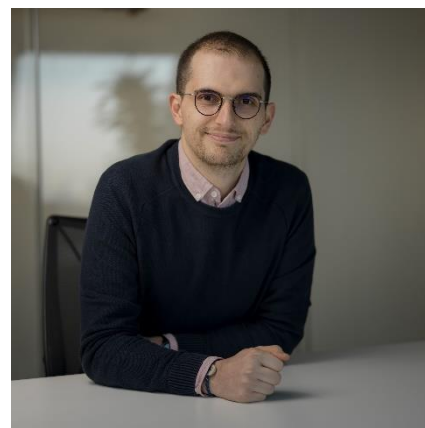


Clément Delhon
