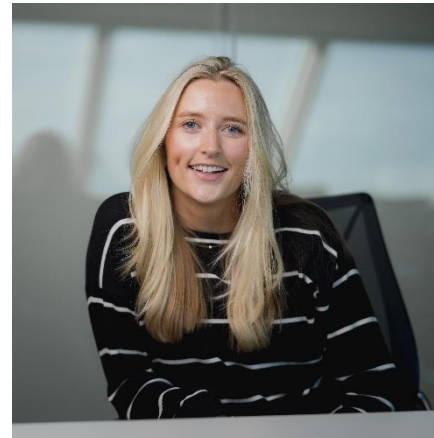
Lucy holds an MSc in Economics (with Distinction) from the London School of Economics and a B.A. in Economics from the University of Cambridge.
