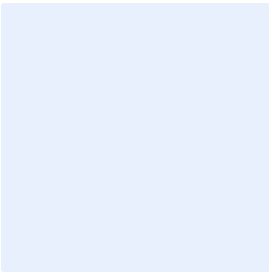


Sancho Pérez
