On mergers, Anton has worked on Phase I and Phase II cases before the European Commission, the UK's Competition and Market Authority and competition authorities in Brazil, Canada, India, Ireland, Russia, Singapore, Türkiye and others.

On Art. 102, Anton advised in relation to self-preferencing, price discrimination, predatory pricing and loyalty rebates.
