



POSTOPERATIVE INSTRUCTIONS FOR PATIENT PICK UPS AFTER SURGERY

PATIENT PICK-UP AND RECOVERY GUIDELINES

1. It is essential that a responsible adult accompany you home following your surgery. You must not be left alone for the first 24 hours after receiving anesthesia.
2. Patients are not permitted to leave the clinic unaccompanied.
3. Patients are required to provide the name and contact number of the individual who will be escorting you home.
4. Your designated escort is welcome to contact our Recovery Room Nursing Station at **437-523-4168** during your procedure to inquire about your anticipated discharge time.
5. Upon arrival, if the clinic doors are locked, your escort should call the Recovery Room Nursing Station at **437-523-4168**, and a staff member will provide access to the building.
6. Once admitted, your escort may wait in the front reception area until they are either invited into the recovery room or it is time for discharge. Please note that entry into the recovery room is at the sole discretion of the recovery room nurse.
