




Illustration shows our most popular swim spa Hydrozone  $\operatorname{Pro+}^{\text{\tiny{TM}}}$  model.








# Hydrozone Pro+™








## Deck/Pit Installation

Follow this step-by-step guide to ensure your spa remains fully accessible for servicing and upgrades, without compromising your deck/pit design.

- 1. Leave space between the decking and the lip of the spa.
- Do not run deck boards flush with the underside of the spa shell.
   This setup is unsafe and not recommended.
- Set the spa at least 400mm above deck height (to the top of the spa): Ensures safe and easy entry/exit. Allows cover safety clips to attach securely to the spa cabinet.
- Avoid finishing the spa lip level with the deck:
   Spa shells are hand-trimmed, so an exact level finish is unreliable.
   Misalignment is likely, especially over time.
- Risk of structural damage: If foundations settle and the spa shell rests on the deck, it can cause cracking or damage. This type of damage is not covered by warranty.





## Deck/Pit Installation



#### 2. Visualise the Invisible Maintenance Corridor

Think of your spa as sitting inside an invisible service zone that technicians need to work freely.

- Leave 1000 mm (1 metre) clearance on the Equipment bay side.
- Leave 500 mm clearance on all other sides, measured from the spa cabinet not the water edge or frame.

**Tip:** The invisible maintenance corridor zone must remain free of posts, joists, steps, balustrades, fencing or other obstructions.


## Deck/Pit Installation

#### 3. Design Around the Swim Spa – Not Over It

Set back deck framing: Position beams outside the service corridor.

- Cantilever your joists to bridge the 500 mm or 1000 mm gap.
- Frame removable hatch panels into the decking that sits over the service zones.
   These hatches allow future access to pumps, plumbing, and equipment without pulling up your deck or dismantling timber.

#### 4. Add Drop-in Lids or Crawl Space Access

Underneath any decking above a service zone:

 Provide drop-in lids or crawl space access. This lets technicians get to every panel on every side of the spa, even those not facing outward.

Long-term servicing, warranty work, and equipment upgrades all depend on this kind of access!




## Deck/Pit Installation

#### 5. Prepare Swim Spa Cabinet Panels Before Decking/Pit (optional)

Before any boards go down:

- Mark a horizontal line just below your planned future deck height on each spa cabinet panel.
- Unscrew and remove the entire panel.
- Cut it in two parts:
  - The upper section will lift out from above the deck.
  - The lower section will slide out through the gap beneath.

Pre-cutting ensures panels can be removed without cutting into the spa's frame, insulation, wiring or plumbing.



#### 6. Reinstall the Cabinet Panels – Now Split for Access

- Once cut: Reinstall the lower section below deck height.
- Store or safely keep the upper section to reattach once the deck is in place.

This prep means panels can be accessed from above or below the deck—without compromising spa structure or warranty.

## Deck/Pit Installation

#### 7. Double-Check Before Final Decking

Before securing your final boards confirm all clearances:

- · 1000 mm on the equipment side
- 500 mm on all other sides
- · Confirm hatch panels and access points align with service zones.
- · Confirm cabinet panels are divided and re-installable.








## Optional ClearLift™ Cover

#### Left-mounted opening




#### Right-mounted opening



If the ClearLift<sup>™</sup> control panel is positioned on the right side of the swim spa, and the ClearLift<sup>™</sup> cover folds to the left, it is considered a **Left-Mounted ClearLift**<sup>™</sup>.

Conversely, if the ClearLift<sup>™</sup> control panel is located on the left side of the swim spa, and the ClearLift<sup>™</sup> cover folds to the right, it is referred to as a **Right-Mounted ClearLift**<sup>™</sup>





Left mount, side view shown in Vortex™ swim spas 1,300mm height.







