Al Ti Color management, aware of the extreme importance of safeguarding and protecting the environment, has implemented an environmental management system in order to improve its environmental performance and mitigate the environmental impacts of its activities.

In order to pursue these aims to the best of its ability, Al Ti Color, after analysing the environmental context of its production sites, has carried out a careful analysis of the environmental aspects and impacts that may arise from the performance of its activities.

To this end, the management is committed to providing adequate resources to:

- Implement and maintain an Environmental Management System consistent with the requirements of the UNI EN ISO 14001 standard
- Assess the direct and indirect environmental impacts linked to the service provided and adopt
 management procedures to ensure that plants and processes offer the greatest protection of the
 environment, workers and interested parties with a view to continuous improvement.
- Prevent pollution
- Ensure compliance with all applicable mandatory obligations and any other requirements to which
 the organisation subscribes concerning its environmental aspects and occupational health and
 safety hazards
- Ensuring that its activities are conducted in strict compliance with operational control and emergency procedures
- Planning its activities in such a way as to minimise its impact on the environment, limit the consumption of energy and natural resources, in the logic of continuous improvement
- Working in synergy with suppliers and intensifying controls of purchased goods by making them aware of the use of sustainable technologies that respect the environment and the implementation of risk reduction methods
- Ensure the availability of all information and resources necessary to achieve the company's environmental objectives and targets
- Periodically reviewing the Environmental Policy to assess its suitability, making any changes, in order to guarantee the pursuit of the objectives of continuous improvement

To this end, the following action points are adopted by the Organisation:

- 1. Empowering its employees to protect the environment through information and staff training programmes.
- 2. Ensuring full cooperation with inspection bodies and local authorities when necessary.
- 3. Monitoring the consumption of resources and taking improvement actions to reduce losses, waste and anomalies.
- 4. Efficient waste management with particular attention to waste sorting and recovery targets.
- 5. Communicate the Environmental Policy to all persons working in or on behalf of the organisation.
- 6. Draw up and implement procedures for environmental management for both normal and accidental conditions that may impact the environment.
