

SUSTAINABLE TRANSPORT



Canberra Airport actively promotes and provides sustainable transport options for workers and passengers of Canberra Airport.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

The AirLiner bus service operates between Canberra City and Canberra Airport, Monday to Friday, every 30 minutes and on Saturday and Sunday approximately every hour.

ACTION Buses service Brindabella Business Park, Majura Park and Fairbairn and include services to Civic, Belconnen, Woden, Weston Creek, Parliamentary Triangle, Gungahlin and Tuggeranong.

Canberra Airport has had a number of promotions to increase public transport numbers, including providing free AirLiner bus tickets to people standing in the Taxi queue.

CYCLE FACILITIES

Cycle paths on and off the new Pialligo Avenue upgrade connects with the broader Canberra cycling networks and provides a safe option for cyclists.

Cycle paths to the Fairbairn precinct will be incorporated in future upgrade and road designs.

Bicycle storage and shower and change facilities are conveniently located across the business parks.

REGIONAL BUS SERVICES

A regional bus stop and marshalling area interlines regional passengers with scheduled aircraft services and facilitate interchange across the bus routes.

The Airport will continue to facilitate affordable and frequent links with destinations such as the south coast, the snowy mountains and other locations in the region.
