Canberra Airport Welcomes Qantas Maintenance Facility

Canberra Airport congratulates Qantas Airways on today's announcement that a maintenance facility will be based in Canberra to service the Qantas aircraft that regularly visit the national capital.

Chief Financial Officer of Canberra Airport, Stephen Carson said it was a very exciting and positive announcement for economic growth and skilled jobs in Canberra.

"Just this week we signed a new Memorandum of Understanding with the ACT Government to continue working closely on how aviation can drive economic growth in our region.

"Both Canberra Airport and the ACT Government have historically strongly supported the location of a significant base and maintenance facility to deliver jobs here, going back as far as Impulse Airlines and, so, the hangar now being used by Qantas was built.
