

# WIN A TRIP TO FIJI 2026 TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The following terms and conditions apply to **WIN A TRIP TO FIJI 2026** competition being conducted by Capital Airport Group Pty Limited ACN 080 711 191 and its related entities (**Competition**).

## Duration:

9am Australian Eastern Daylight Time (AEDT) Friday 13 March 2026 to 12:30pm (AEDT) Friday 24 April 2026.

## Prize:

Return flights for two (2) with Fiji Airways between Canberra and Fiji. The winner must book and accept the prize between 1 May 2026 and 31 December 2027, departing and returning before 31 December 2027.

There is one (1) prize to be won. The value of the Prize is AUD \$2,500.

The Prize does not include visa application and associated costs, applicable government taxes, surcharges, accommodation, transfers, meals, spending money, or cover incidental costs, which the winner may incur in conjunction with the Prize.

## Notes:

3. Travel is valid on Fiji Airways operated prime services only. Travel restrictions apply from time to time, due to commercial demand.
4. Reservations and ticketing must be made through the Fiji Airways Customer Experience office. This must be done at least ten (10) working days prior to the requested date of departure. The winner must have their passport details and travel dates available at the time of booking.
5. The Prize is not transferable or exchangeable and cannot be taken as cash. Name changes are not permitted. Once

ticketed, normal fare rules and conditions of carriage apply.

6. Winners must be over the age of 18+.
7. Ticket holders must be accompanied by someone over the age of 18+.

## Entry conditions:

1. These are the terms and conditions of entry into the Competition (**Terms**). By entering into the Competition, you are deemed to have accepted these Terms.
2. The promoter is Capital Airport Group Pty Limited ACN 080 711 191 and its related entities (**Promoter**).
3. The Prize supplier is Fiji Airways (**Suppliers**).
4. The Competition opens at 9am (AEDT) Friday 13 March 2026 and will close at 12:30pm (AEDT) on Friday 24 April 2026 (**Competition Period**).
5. All entries must be received by the Promoter during the Competition Period.
6. Entry to the Competition is open to all residents of Australia over 18 years of age, excluding employees of the Promoter and Supplier and other agencies, firms or companies associated with the Competition, and their immediate families (**Eligible Entrants**).   13. The winner of the Prize will be notified by telephone within two (2) business days of the draw. The winner will also be notified by email and the winner's name may be published electronically on the Promoter's website. The winner must collect their prize from the Promoter's office at Level 4, 21 Terminal Avenue, Plaza Offices – West, Canberra Airport ACT 2609.

  15. In the event that the winner is unable to be contacted within 5 business days of being notified, or if the winner is ineligible or fails to comply with the terms and conditions, the Prize will be deemed forfeited. The Promoter will not be liable for a winner that forfeits their prize and no correspondence has been entered into.
  16. All entrants acknowledge that the Promoter collects personal information in order to conduct the Competition and may, for this purpose, disclose this information to third parties, agents, contractors, service providers. Entry is conditional on providing this information.

If there is a dispute as to the identity of an entrant, the Promoter reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to determine the identity of the entrant.
  19. The Promoter's decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into about the Competition, excluding regulatory organisation obligations.
  20. Any ancillary costs associated with winning the Competition are not covered by the Promoter or the Supplier. These costs need to be funded by the Prize winner.

Except for any liability that cannot by law be excluded, the Promoter and Supplier (including their respective officers, employees and agents) are not responsible for and exclude all liability (including negligence), for any personal injury or any loss or damage (including loss of opportunity), whether direct, indirect, special or consequential, arising in any way out of:
    - (a) any technical difficulties or equipment malfunction (whether or

- not under the Promoter's control);
  - (b) any theft, unauthorised access or third party interference;
  - (c) any entry that is late, lost, altered, damaged or misdirected (whether or not after receipt by the Promoter) due to any reason beyond the reasonable control of the Promoter; or
  - (d) accepting or using a Prize (even if caused by negligence).
25. The Promoter may terminate the Competition for any reason in its absolute discretion by publishing a notice of termination on the Promoter's website. The termination will be effective from the date stated in the notice.
