

Terms and Conditions

Trade Promotions - Games of Skill - Fresh Fest - Scavenger Hunt

These Terms and Conditions include terms that limit the Promoter's liability to you, entitle the Promoter to use your name, likeness and voice in connection with this Competition and permit the Promoter to disclose your personal information to third parties (in accordance with the Promoter's Privacy Policy <https://www.canberraairport.com.au/privacy-policy>)).

Information on how to enter and prizes form part of these conditions. By participating, entrants agree to be bound by these conditions. Entries must comply with these conditions to be valid. As a condition of accepting a prize, the winner must comply with all terms and conditions of use of the prize and with the directions of the Promoter's and any prize suppliers' representatives.

The following terms and conditions apply to the **Fresh Fest - Scavenger Hunt (Promotion)** being conducted by Capital Airport Group Pty Limited ACN 080 711 191 of 21 Terminal Avenue, Plaza Offices - West, Canberra Airport ACT 2609 (**Promoter**).

Duration: The Competition commences at 10.00 AEST on 27/06/26 and closes at 15:00 AEST on 27/06/26, or earlier once all prizes have been awarded (whichever occurs first) (**Entry Period**).

Prize: Prize consists of 1 x Fresh Fest Tote Bag (RRP \$5) including:

- 1 x Write to the Raiders letter template or kids to complete and send to the Raiders (RRP \$0.50),
- 1 x Colouring in Sheet (RRP \$0.50),
- 1 x Colouring in bag (RRP \$3) or Mini Easel & Paint (RPP \$3) (items will be provided at random),
- 1 x McDonalds Voucher for a small sundae (RRP\$7.00) (items will be provided at random).

There are 100 prizes to be won. Total RRP value of all prizes = \$1,800. All prize values are correct as at 22/06/26 and are in Australian dollars. Use of a vouchers is subject to the Voucher Conditions described in clause 9.

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1. Entry is open to residents of ACT & NSW.
2. Entrants who are under the age of 18 must seek permission from their parent or guardian to enter.
3. Employees of the Promoter, any prize drawers and any agencies, firms or companies associated with this Competition are ineligible to enter.

5. Incomplete or illegible entries will be deemed invalid. Limit applies of one entry per person. The Promoter reserves the right to implement queue management processes, including closing the queue prior to the advertised end time where demand exceeds reasonable capacity.
6. Entries must be received by the Promoter during the Entry Period. Entries received after all prizes have been allocated will not be accepted, even if within the Entry Period.
7. This Competition is not a game of chance. The first 100 valid entries received (as determined by the Promoter) in accordance with these conditions will each receive a prize, while stocks last. Entries will be deemed received at the time they are physically submitted at the designated collection point.
8. Prizes will be available for collection on the day at the exit gate of the Fresh Fest Event, from Event staff and must be claimed at the time of submission of entry, unless otherwise directed by the Promoter. If an entrant is not present to collect their prize when notified, the Promoter may allocate the prize to the next valid entrant. The Promoter reserves the right to verify the validity of entries before awarding a prize.

If still unresolved within a further 14 days of being escalated, then the senior Promoter manager will make a final and binding decision subject to any legal proceedings initiated by the complainant.
