

Terms and Conditions

Trade Promotions - Games of Chance - Fresh Fest Grocery Draw

These Terms and Conditions include terms that limit the Promoter's liability to you, entitle the Promoter to use your name, likeness and voice in connection with this Promotion and permit the Promoter to disclose your personal information to third parties (in accordance with the Promoter's Privacy Policy <https://www.majuraparkshopping.com.au/privacy>).

Information on how to enter and prizes form part of these conditions. By participating, entrants agree to be bound by these conditions. Entries must comply with these conditions to be valid. As a condition of accepting a prize, the winner must comply with all terms and conditions of use of a prize and with the directions of the Promoter's and any prize supplier's representatives.

There are 8 prizes to be won. Total RRP value of all prizes = \$1,600. All prize values are correct as at 23/06/26 and are in Australian dollars. Use of a voucher is subject to the Voucher Conditions described in clause 8.

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1. Entry is open to residents of ACT and NSW aged 18 years of age and over.

Woolworths Voucher	The Woolworths Voucher must be used in accordance with the terms and conditions imposed by Woolworths including: Woolworths and Partner Gift Cards terms - Everyday Gifting. a. Voucher may be Redeemed at Participating Stores in Australia up to the value loaded onto the Card. Value Redeemed is deducted from the Card Balance. b.
