Background and Incident: The left hand wheel separated from a towed ATV trailer while travelling on the public highway. Fortunately the wheel embedded into a roadside hedge and was easily recovered. The WoF had expired 4 months ago!

Injury Details: No injuries – but high potential for harm or property damage.

Risk Awareness: A poorly maintained trailer can be a hazard to yourself and other road users. No matter how good you are at towing, you can never tow a badly maintained trailer well and safely.

Safe Behaviours: At PF Olsen branches, equipment is purchased and pooled for use. This requires extra diligence both before and after use. When using trailers, check the:

- 1. WoF and registration stickers are present and current.
- 2. Coupling is compatible with the towball, the securing chains/shackles are present and, if fitted with brakes, for fluid (or lack of it) in the system.
- 3. Tyres have no nicks and cuts, adequate tread and are correctly inflated.
- 4. All wheel nuts present and tight, no excessive side movement in wheels.
- 5. Electrical fittings are sound and all lights and indicators are operational.
- 6. Structure is sound nothing loose and no visible sign of weld cracks.
- 7. Cleanliness and arrange for servicing and/or repairs if required.
- 8. Complete regular inspections on trailers and other pooled equipment.
