50 TONS OF E COLI CARROTS ACROSS THREE LOCATIONS

THE CHALLENGE:

This national logistics company, the transportation partner for a large farm, faced a challenge when the farm recalled its organic carrots due to an E Coli outbreak. Having already loaded the carrots onto their trucks, the logistics company reached out to Vanguard Renewables to help manage the 50 tons of packaged carrots from three impacted locations. This was a challenge, as our partners in the service area typically send packaged organics to animal feed, which was not an option due to the material's E Coli potential.

Our team coordinated internally to identify and confirm disposal outlets within 24 hours for the client. All 50 tons of carrots were depackaged and the organic materials were composted.
