Overall Educational Objective	To understand microeconomic concepts and analysis, to learn mathematical tools to solve consumer-related and firm-related problems.
Course Description	The aim of this course is to make students knowledgeable about the foundation theories of basic microeconomics including an introduction to the study of economics and analyses of economic agents' behaviors, particularly that of the individual and the firm. The interaction between economic agents and the analysis/comparison of market structures are also included. This course is the continuation of Microeconomic Theory I.
